### WHY CHANGE

- A lot of testers not being certified.
- Varying level of quality.

#### Goals:

- To make the process more streamlined
- Easier on the contractor without losing quality.
- Rely more on manufacture's certification.
- To allow more flexibility.

### **OVERVIEW OF CHANGES**

- Separated Installation and Closure Certifications.
- Created "UST Technician" certification.
- Created "Cathodic Protection Tester"
   Certification.
- Added Experience requirement for new applicants.
- Modified Rule 3.12 Enforcement section.



### NEW STRUCTURE OF MDEQ CERTIFICATION

(4 SEPARATE CERTIFICATIONS)

- Certified MDEQ UST Closure
- Certified MDEQ UST Installation
  - Considered to possess the skills needed as a UST Technician if you met the test equipment manufacturers certifications
- Certified MDEQ UST Technician
- Certified Cathodic Protection Tester



### PHASING IN NEW LICENSES

(WHAT SHOULD YOU DO AS A CURRENT INSTALLER?)

- Current Install / Closure licenses will remain in place until recertification due date.
- At recertification due date:
  - Provide MDEQ with all manufacturers certifications required to install UST equipment. (Ex. Xerxes, Containment Solutions, Nupi)
  - Provide MDEQ with all test equipment certifications required to test UST equipment. (Ex. Estabrooks, Petrotite, Acurite)
- You will be issued separate licenses for Install and Closure if you choose to keep both (16 hrs continuing Ed required)
- You may reduce certification to just closure or installation (8 hrs continuing Ed required)
- You may reduce certifications from Install / Close to the UST Technician Certification (8 hrs continuing Ed required)
- Within 2 years:
  - Provide MDEQ with Cathodic Protection tester certification from NACE, STI, or other approved certification.
  - You will be issued separate MDEQ license as a Cathodic Protection Tester.

### NEW CERTIFICATION RENEWAL APPLICATION

To be completed when you apply for recertification.

### UST TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATION

(WHAT ARE THE LIMITS OF WHAT YOU CAN DO?)

- You can:
  - Perform "Non-Invasive repairs"
    - Includes <u>removal</u> or <u>installation</u> of dispensers, line leak detectors, overfill devices, ATG probes or sensors.
    - Includes <u>repair</u> to existing sump penetration fittings, anchoring of shear valves, spill buckets.
- You cannot:
  - Do anything requiring a critical juncture equivalent to classification as an "Installation" or "Alteration" (Will explain next slide)
  - You cannot remove or install STPs, shear valves, or any repair that requires excavation or drilling.

### UST INSTALLER CERTIFICATION

(CRITICAL JUNCTURES)

#### "Installation"

- Preparation of the excavation.
- Setting of tanks, piping, tank anchoring devices, backfilling and strapping.
- Any time components of the piping below ground are disconnected or are being disconnected or connected
- All pressure testing performed during installation
- Completion of backfill and filling of excavation

#### "Alteration"

- Excavation of existing tanks, piping, secondary containment sumps, tank risers, spill buckets or vents.
- Actual performance of the alteration to the tanks, piping below ground, tank risers, or vents
- Anytime the components of the UST system below ground are disconnected or are being disconnected, connected, repaired, or replaced excluding repairs classified as non-invasive.

### IF YOUR NOT CURRENTLY CERTIFIED

(WHEN YOU GET CERTIFIED MATTERS)

## PRIOR TO IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW REGULATIONS

- Certifications issued by MDEQ will consist of Installation / Closure only.
- Current regulation requirements will be applicable for certification.
- New licenses will be phased in when you apply for recertification.

# AFTER IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW REGULATIONS

- Certifications issued by MDEQ will include UST Installation, UST Closure, UST Technician, and CP tester.
- You will have 6 months to get certified under the new regulation requirements.
- That includes Cathodic Protection certification if you wish to test CP.

### UST CLOSURE CERTIFICATION

- 8 hrs continuing education from MDEQ approved course.
- Passing score on MDEQ UST closure exam.
- Two (2) years experience under an MDEQ licensed removal contractor.
- Proof of Financial Responsibility (Minimum \$50,000)

### UST INSTALLER CERTIFICATION

- 8 hours continuing education from an MDEQ approved course.
- Passing score on MDEQ UST Installation exam.
- Two (2) years of experience under an MDEQ licensed Installer.
- Must be certified by UST equipment manufacture to install, alter, or test if certification is available thru the manufacturer for the activity.
- Proof of Financial Responsibility (Minimum \$50,000)

### UST TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATION

- 8 hours continuing education from an MDEQ approved course.
- Passing score on MDEQ UST technician exam.
- One (I) year of experience under an MDEQ licensed Installer or Technician.
- Must be certified by UST equipment manufacture to install, alter, or test if certification is available thru the manufacturer for the activity.
- Proof of Financial Responsibility (Minimum \$50,000)

### UST CATHODIC PROTECTION TESTER

- Certification from an approved MDEQ cathodic protection tester course.
  - Approved Courses currently include:
    - Alabama Petroleum Equipment Contractors (ALPEC)
    - NACE
    - Petcon, Inc.
    - Steel Tank Institute

### THE EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENT

(HOW TO MEET IT)

- Only applies to new applicants.
- May be met by:
  - W-2 showing employment
  - Letter endorsing applicant written by another licensed individual
  - MDEQ approved equivalent



### MODIFIED RULE 3.12 ENFORCEMENT SECTION

(FORMERLY "REVOCATION, DENIAL, AND NON-RENEWAL O F CERTIFICATES")

- Renamed Rule to coincide with Rule 3.13 Enforcement and Appeals process.
- Added:
  - "The Commission may penalize the certificate holder in lieu of or in addition to revocation, denial, and non-renewal of any certificate."
    - Reason being: To designate authority to Commission.
- Added:
  - "Failure to follow provisions of Certification Requirements."
    - Reason being: To allow jurisdiction for enforcement if Certification requirements are not met.
