Available Solid Waste Management Facilities in **Storm Impacted Counties**

(Lowndes and Tishomingo Counties and Vicinity) February 28, 2019

The recent tornado events in northeast Mississippi created significant damage and debris in the impacted communities. There are several solid waste management facilities in these areas that are available for disposal of storm debris subject to the operating conditions of the facility, the type of debris to be disposed, and the approval of the site operator. MDEQ encourages interested persons to also contact local officials to determine other local debris collection and clean-up options that may be available. The solid waste facilities identified below can accept solid waste materials for disposal as follows:
