

WARREN COUNTY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14TH FOR FLOOD RESPONSE AND CLEAN UP

The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) is working with local officials in Warren County to host a collection day at the Eagle Lake Boat Landing to collect Household Hazardous Wastes (HHW), certain electronic wastes, and bulky household appliances and white goods generated or damaged as a result of the impacts from the Mississippi River flooding in 2019.

What can residents bring?



- Household chemicals, bleach and cleaners, and disinfectants;
- Ant/roach sprays and poisons, and other insecticides;
- Pool chemicals;
- Lead acid batteries;
- Used oil, gasoline, antifreeze, and other fuel products;
- Paints, thinners, stains and solvents;
- Thermostats, lighting ballasts, capacitors, and other similar items;
- Herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizers;
- Other hazardous chemicals found in the home;
- Large bulky household appliances such as refrigerators, washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, and hot water heaters; and
- Electronic wastes such as televisions, cell phones, and computers.



MDEQ and local officials are asking residents to collect these materials in the original containers where possible and to transport the materials to the collection site established below:
