Water Permit Applications

FORM 1

Any new "Greenfield" or existing stationary source that will be applying for a water permit will need to complete and submit a FORM 1.

Types of Regulated Wastewater

Process Wastewater, Non-contact Cooling Water, Sanitary, Boiler Blowdown, Stormwater, Animal Waste, Aquaculture, Mining, etc.

Process Wastewater

Process Wastewater is wastewater that comes in direct contact with or results from the production or use of any raw material, intermediate product, finished product, byproduct, waste product, or wastewater.

<u>Permit to Discharge Wastewater for Existing Facilities (FORM 2C)</u>

Any existing stationary source that is intends to discharge wastewater from existing operations to waters of the U.S.

Permit to Discharge Wastewater (FORM 2D)

Any new "Greenfield" stationary source that intends to discharge process wastewater to waters of the U.S.

No Discharge of Process Wastewater (FORM 2E)

Any new or existing stationary source that intends to discharge only nonprocess wastewater.

Permit to Discharge Industrial Stormwater Only (FORM 2F)

Any new "Greenfield" or existing stationary source that only intends to discharge stormwater discharges associated with an industrial activity to waters of the U.S.

Permit to Discharge Wastewater to a POTW (FORM 2P)

Any new "Greenfield" or existing stationary source that intends to discharge wastewater to a POTW.

Permit to Treat Wastewater with No Discharge (FORM 2SOP)

Any new "Greenfield" or existing stationary source that intends to treat wastewater but not discharge it to waters of the U.S. or a POTW.
