QUIT CLAIM DEED

THIS OUIT CLAIM DEED is made on this 17th day of November, 1999 by ORKIN EXTERMINATING COMPANY, INC. a Delaware corporation, ("Grantor"), to ORKIN EXTERMINATING COMPANY, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Grantee"), pursuant to the requirements of that certain Agreed Order entered on May 4, 1999 as Case No. 3814 99 before the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (referred to herein as the "Agreed Order") between Grantor and the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Agreed Order relates to that certain Corrective Action Plan dated April 1997 (referred to herein as the "Corrective Action Plan") approved by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (referred to herein as the "MDEQ") for the real property described below (referred to herein as the "Orkin Site"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreed Order requires that Grantor execute a deed to itself containing as covenants certain requirements set forth in the Agreed Order, which covenants shall run with the land and be enforceable against any subsequent purchaser or grantee of the Orkin Site.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars (\$10.00), cash in hand paid and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged and agreed, ORKIN EXTERMINATING COMPANY, INC., a Delaware corporation, does hereby SELL, CONVEY and QUIT-CLAIM unto ORKIN EXTERMINATING COMPANY, INC., a Delaware corporation, the following described tract, piece or parcel of property, located and situated in Forrest County, Mississippi, as per plat attached hereto as Exhibit A, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

> Commence at the Southwest corner of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 4 North, Range 13 West, Forrest County, Mississippi and run East for 101,57 feet to a 1/2" iron pipe, the North right-of-way line of Helveston paved public road and the point of beginning. From the point of beginning run N 04°16'23"W for 211.25 feet to a ½" iron pipe; Thence run N 85° 45'08"E for 78.50 feet to a 3/4" iron pipe; Thence run N 00° 28'23"E for 114.53 feet to a 1" iron pipe; Thence run S88°44'28"E for 48.95 feet to a ½" rebar; I CERTIFY THIS INSTRUMENT Thence run South for 329.93 feet to a 1/2" rebar and back to the aforementioned North right-of-way line; Thence run West for 112.43 feet back to the point of beginning. Dole, a widow, individually and as sole shareholder and owner of all equities and property interests of Harry Dole Dodge, Inc., a Mississippi Corporation administratively dissolved on May 1, 1989 by Warranty Deed as recorded in Deed Book 757 at Page 93 in the Office of the Chancery Clerk of Forrest County, Mississippi

Grantee and its successors and assigns, shall advise and obtain approval from the MDEQ prior to conveyance of any property interest involving the Orkin Site. Grantee and its successors and assigns also shall advise any potential purchasers/grantees of the Orkin Site that a purchaser/grantee to the Orkin Site will be required to enter into an Agreed Order with the MDEQ stating that prior to any construction, excavation, or drilling on the Premises or change in its use, including, but not limited to, for commercial, residential, industrial, recreational, educational, agricultural or any other use of the Orkin Site by Grantee or any subsequent purchaser/grantee, that notice must be given to and approval obtained from MDEQ.

Grantee shall be responsible for monitoring and maintaining the Orkin Site and for any additional remedial activity required by MDEQ.

The covenants hereinabove set forth shall be covenants which shall run with the land and be enforceable against any subsequent purchaser/grantee of the Orkin Site. Grantee shall include in any deed and/or other instrument of conveyance to a subsequent purchaser/grantee of the Orkin Site the requirement regarding MDEQ approval prior to any change in use and the obligation to operate and maintain the Orkin Site as set forth hereinabove.

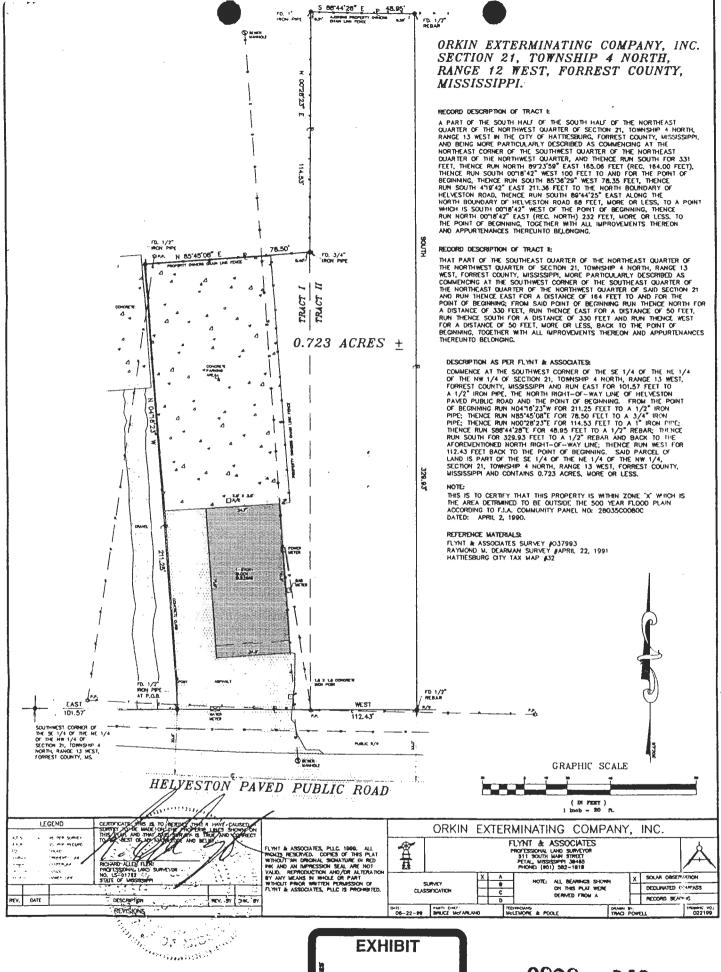
