INSTRUCTIONS

FOR COMPLETION OF "RENEWAL/RE-CERTIFICATION APPLICATION FOR LEAD CERTIFICATION"

PURPOSE

Applications for renewal and re-certification must be submitted per Chapter II of the Regulations for Lead-Based Paint Activities to maintain Mississippi certification and to receive a current photo identification card for inspector, risk assessor, supervisor, project designer, renovator, dust sampling technician, and abatement worker.

PREPARATION

All information is to be completed by applicant and must be filled out completely, typed or printed in ink. Pencil is not acceptable.

INSTRUCTIONS

Enter your full name, social security number, address, city, state, zip code as you want it to appear on your photo identification card. Telephone number should be complete with area code. Enter your date of birth (month/day/year), sex (male/female), height (feet and inches) and weight (pounds).

Indicate type of application submitted: renewal or re-certification.

Indicate which discipline of certification requested (one discipline per application).

Indicate appropriate fee. The certification is \$150.00 for all categories, except the fee for individuals applying for certification as renovator or worker. The certification fee for renovator is \$75.00 unless the individual is the 1st or 2nd Certified Renovator associated with the Certified Firm. The 1st and 2nd Certified Renovators for a Certified Firm are exempt from the certification fee. The certification fee for worker is \$35.00.

Indicate Employer's name, mailing address, city, state, zip code, telephone and fax number complete with area code.

MAINTAINING CERTIFICATION

To maintain certification in a particular discipline, per Chapter II of the Regulations for Lead-Based Paint Activities, an individual must:

- a. Successfully complete the required refresher training course for the particular discipline every three (3) years following successful completion of the initial training course;
- b. Renew each certificate annually during the period of training; and
- c. Be re-certified by the Commission in that discipline every three years after having successfully completed the appropriate accredited refresher training course.

Read the affidavit carefully. If a forged certificate or any misinformation is found to exist, the individual may be subject to revocation of certification. The application shall be signed and dated by you, the applicant.

REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

Confirmation of refresher training shall be in the form of an original certificate of completion of the accredited refresher training course bearing the training provider's official seal, or an original letter from the training provider confirming completion of the course on the training provider's letterhead, or an original letter from the training provider listing names of persons who have successfully completed the training course, with the applicant's name included. Applications submitted for re-certification without original refresher training certificates will be returned as incomplete.

Enclose check or money order in the correct amount depending on certification requested. Make check or money order payable to Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (please note "LEAD" on your check or money order).

DO NOT SEND CASH.

When applying for re-certification, enclose three (3) photographs of the applicant to be used for the Mississippi Certification Photo Identification card. Photographs shall be in color and 1¼" x 1¼" in size with the applicant's name and social security number printed on the back. Applications for recertification submitted without photographs will be returned as incomplete.
