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## **INTRODUCTION**

The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) developed this status report to provide information on solid waste disposal activities that were conducted during Calendar Year 2002 at all permitted landfills and rubbish sites within the State of Mississippi. An annual report on the solid waste disposal activities conducted at each landfill and rubbish site in the state is due to MDEQ from the facility owner each year by February 28<sup>th</sup>. This status report provides summary information on the amounts of solid waste disposed at both commercial and non-commercial disposal facilities as listed below:

## Part I - Commercial Solid Waste Disposal Facilities

Part I of this report contains a summary report on disposal activities conducted at commercial disposal facilities in the state. A commercial solid waste disposal facility means any facility that is engaged in the disposal of solid waste for compensation or which accepts waste from more than one generator not owned by the facility owner. Commercial solid waste disposal facilities include:

- Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfills
- ➤ Non-Municipal Solid Waste (non-MSW) Landfills
- Class I and Class II Rubbish Sites

### Part II - Non-Commercial Solid Waste Disposal Facilities

Part II of this report contains a summary report on disposal activities conducted at non-commercial disposal facilities. A non-commercial solid waste disposal facility means a facility that receives solid waste from one generator and where the disposal facility is not operated for compensation. Non-commercial solid waste disposal facilities include:

- > Industrial Landfills
- > Industrial and Institutional Rubbish Sites

This status report contains information that may be utilized by local government officials and/or solid waste decision makers, disposal facility owners and operators, state agencies and other organizations. The information provided includes the following:

- 1. The total amount of waste received at each permitted solid waste disposal facility as reported by the facility owners/operators;
- 2. An estimated remaining life at solid waste disposal facilities as reported by the facility owners/operators; and
- 3. State maps showing the approximate geographic locations of each disposal facility.

Copies of this report will be provided to local government officials and/or solid waste decision makers to assist them in planning for the management of solid wastes in their jurisdictions. A

copy of this status report will also be provided to the Mississippi State Tax Commission for verification of the information that the State Tax Commission receives from commercial facility owners/operators each year.

This report indicates that a total of approximately 5,349,615 tons of solid waste was disposed during Calendar Year 2002 at commercial and non-commercial landfills and rubbish sites in Mississippi. Approximately 54.37% of the total waste was disposed at commercial landfills, 28.76% at non-commercial landfills, 16.46% at commercial rubbish sites, and 0.41% was disposed at non-commercial rubbish sites (see Figure: 1 below).



This status report also indicates that Mississippi received a total of 620,825 tons of solid waste from out-of-state sources representing 11.61% of the total solid waste that was disposed in Mississippi during Calendar Year 2002. Commercial landfills received approximately 538,910 tons and commercial rubbish sites received approximately 81,915 tons of out-of-state waste.


## Part I - Commercial Solid Waste Disposal Facilities

## Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfills

Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfills are disposal facilities that are designed and constructed to receive a wide range of nonhazardous solid wastes for disposal including household garbage, nonhazardous industrial wastes, and special wastes such as asbestos or treated medical wastes. There were seventeen (17) MSW landfills that actively received solid wastes during Calendar Year 2002.

An annual report on the solid waste disposal activities conducted at each MSW landfill is required by the Mississippi Code Annotated *Section 17-17-219* (Supp. 2002) and *Section IV.B.14* of the Mississippi Nonhazardous Waste Management Regulations. This report contains a summary of these individual facility reports as provided by the facility owners. The report includes the following information:

- 1. A state map showing the approximate geographic locations of all MSW landfills;
- 2. A summary of operational information contained in the individual annual reports for Calendar Year 2002 for MSW landfills; and
- 3. Individual state maps for the 17 active MSW landfills including geographic locations, the geographic areas serviced with the amount of wastes received in tons/year, and other pertinent information.






## Part I - Commercial Solid Waste Disposal Facilities

## Non-Municipal Solid Waste (non-MSW) Landfills

Non-Municipal Solid Waste (non-MSW) Landfills are disposal facilities that are designed and constructed to receive a limited range of nonhazardous solid wastes, such as industrial sludges and ashes, and special wastes, such as asbestos, for disposal. These landfills generally received waste from either one primary industrial source or received one primary waste stream. These facilities are not authorized to accept household garbage or other similar wastes. There were five (5) permitted non-MSW landfills that actively received solid wastes during Calendar Year 2002.

An annual report on the solid waste disposal activities conducted at each non-MSW landfill is required by the Mississippi Code Annotated *Section 17-17-219* (Supp. 2002) and *Section IV.B.14* of the Mississippi Nonhazardous Waste Management Regulations. This report contains a summary of these individual facility reports as provided by the facility owners. The report includes the following information:

- 1. A state map showing the approximate geographic locations of all non-MSW landfills; and
- 2. A summary of operational information contained in the individual annual reports for Calendar Year 2002 for non-MSW landfills.

## Part I - Commercial Solid Waste Disposal Facilities

### Class I and Class II Rubbish Sites

Class I and Class II Rubbish Sites are facilities that are designed and constructed to receive rubbish wastes from a variety of sources for disposal. Rubbish is a subset of the overall municipal solid waste stream generated in the State of Mississippi. A significant amount of rubbish wastes are managed and disposed of each year at commercial rubbish disposal facilities across the state. There were seventy-six (76) commercial class I rubbish sites and sixty-three (63) commercial class II rubbish sites with active solid waste permits during Calendar Year 2002.


Class I rubbish sites may accept all solid wastes that are defined as rubbish wastes. These wastes generally include the following:

- construction and demolition debris
- brick, mortar, concrete, stone, and asphalt;
- ◆ cardboard;
- natural vegetation;
- appliances which have had the motor removed (except refrigerators);
- furniture;
- plastic, glass, crockery, and metal (except containers); and
- sawdust, wood shavings, and wood chips

Class II rubbish sites may accept limited types of inert rubbish wastes. These inert wastes include natural vegetation, brick, mortar, concrete, stone, and asphalt.

An annual report on the solid waste disposal activity conducted at each rubbish site is required by the Mississippi Code Annotated, *Section 17-17-219* (Supp. 2002), *Section T* of Statewide General Permit No. SWGP-R1 for class I rubbish sites, and *Section R* of Statewide General Permit No. SWGP-R2 for class II rubbish sites. This report contains a summary of these individual facility reports as provided by the facility owners. The report includes the following information:

- 1. A state map showing the approximate geographic locations of class I rubbish sites;
- 2. A summary of the information provided by rubbish site owners in the individual annual reports for Calendar Year 2002 for class I rubbish sites in Mississippi. The information is listed alphabetically by County;
- 3. A state map showing the approximate locations of class II rubbish sites; and
- 4. A summary of the information provided by rubbish site owners in the individual annual reports for Calendar Year 2002 for class II rubbish sites in the State of Mississippi. The information is listed alphabetically by County.




## Part II - Non-Commercial Solid Waste Disposal Facilities

### **Industrial Landfills**

Industrial Landfills are disposal facilities that are designed and constructed to receive nonhazardous industrial wastes and certain special wastes from one primary source for ultimate disposal. These disposal facilities are generally owned and operated by the industry or institution that generates the wastes. There were twenty-five (25) permitted industrial landfills with active solid waste permits during Calendar Year 2002.

An annual report on the solid waste disposal activities conducted at each industrial landfill is required by the individual facility permit conditions. This report contains a summary report on the disposal activities conducted at industrial landfills in Mississippi during Calendar Year 2002. The report includes the following information:

- 1. A state map showing the approximate geographic locations of all industrial landfills; and
- 2. A summary of operational information contained in the individual annual reports for Calendar Year 2002 for industrial landfills.


## **Industrial and Institutional Rubbish Sites**

Industrial and Institutional Rubbish Sites are facilities that are designed and constructed to receive class I and/or class II rubbish wastes from industrial or institutional sources for disposal. These disposal facilities are generally owned and operated by the industry or institution that generates the wastes and are categorized as either class I or class II rubbish sites depending upon the types of waste disposed. There were twenty-one (21) permitted industrial or institutional rubbish sites that operated during Calendar Year 2002.

An annual report on the solid waste disposal activity conducted at each rubbish site is required by *Section T* of Statewide General Permit No. SWGP-R1 for class I rubbish sites and *Section R* of Statewide General Permit No. SWGP-R2 for class II rubbish sites. This report contains a summary of the individual facility reports as reported by the facility owners. The report includes the following information:

- 1. A state map showing the approximate geographic locations of all industrial and institutional rubbish sites; and
- 2. A summary of the information provided by the rubbish site owners in the individual annual reports for Calendar Year 2002 for all non-commercial rubbish sites in Mississippi. The information is listed alphabetically by County.
