

**MINUTES OF THE MISSISSIPPI ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PERMIT BOARD  
HELD IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, ON TUESDAY, APRIL 8, 2014**

The Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board held a meeting in the Commission Hearing Room of the Department of Environmental Quality, located at 515 East Amite Street, on April 8, 2014. Roy Furrh and Lisa Ouzts were present as legal counsel. On motion by Jim Lipe and seconded by Mike Bograd, the minutes of the regular meeting on March 18, 2014, were approved.

**REPORT OF STAFF PERMIT ACTIONS/CERTIFICATIONS**

Staff reported to the Permit Board that staff had taken action on various permits since the March 18, 2014, Permit Board Meeting pursuant to the regulations delegating this authority to the Executive Director and the Executive Director's delegation of this authority to the staff in accord with those regulations. The Permit Board voted to note and record in its minutes the reports of permit actions/certifications by staff since the March 18, 2014, Permit Board Meeting. [Jim Hoffmann abstained from voting on all Land and Water Resources permits and Mike Bograd abstained on all of the Office of Geology permits.]

Mr. Riecke abstained from voting to approve inclusion in the Permit Board minutes of permit actions taken since the last meeting by the Office of Land and Water Resources report stating that the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks will not vote to approve any more new surface water withdrawal permits from Deer Creek until they see a sustainability study on whether the Deer Creek System can handle any new surface water withdrawal permits.

**THE PERMIT BOARD CONSIDERED THE FOLLOWING  
OFFICE OF POLLUTION CONTROL MATTERS:

**Issuance of the State Operating No Discharge Permit for Groundworx, LLC, Forrest and Lamar Counties, MSU213009**

Mr. Harry Wilson, Division Chief of MDEQ's Environmental Permits Division, presented Groundworx, LLC's application for a State Operating No Discharge Permit for a proposed wastewater treatment system to be located in Forrest and Lamar Counties. Mr. Wilson advised the Permit Board that the City of Hattiesburg is subject to an Agreed Order with the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality to come into compliance with its current National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit. To address its compliance issues, the Hattiesburg City Council voted to enter into a contract with Groundworx, LLC to install a no discharge wastewater treatment system that involves land application of treated effluent on land controlled by Groundworx. Mr. Wilson advised the Board that MDEQ held a public hearing on February 25, 2014, to receive public comments regarding the proposed permit. Mr. Wilson further advised the Board that MDEQ revised the draft proposed permit after reviewing public comments. Mr. Wilson stated that the extensive monitoring, limitations, reporting, and plans specified in the proposed permit will help ensure compliance and recommended that the Permit Board issue the permit.

Pastor D. Franklin Browne was present and spoke in opposition to the proposed permit. Pastor Browne had concerns that the chemicals used to treat the wastewater would be released into the environment. Pastor Browne was also concerned that the release of odor-causing gases and the production of mold during wastewater application would adversely affect the environment and the mental and physical health of the public. Pastor Browne questioned the fairness of releasing waste in rural areas when most of the waste was generated in the City.

Mr. Gary Rikard, Attorney for Groundworx, LLC, also addressed the Permit Board. Mr. Rikard stated that there had been several meetings and careful planning in developing the proposed permit. Mr. Rikard stated that Groundworx participated in several meetings with the citizens and leaders of Hattiesburg to discuss options for the City's wastewater treatment. Mr. Rikard stated that the proposed wastewater treatment system will be the most environmentally protective and economical option available to the City. Mr. Matt Gatlin, Mr. Ronnie Blackwell, and Mr. Lane Reidenburk, engineers for Groundworx, answered the Permit Board's questions regarding the proposed treatment system.

On motion by Jim Lipe and seconded by David Snodgrass the Permit Board voted to accept MDEQ staff's recommendation and issue the permit. Dennis Riecke abstained on behalf of the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks.

**OTHER BUSINESS**

Roy Furrh reminded the Permit Board of the May 1, 2014, deadline on filing statements of economic interest with the State Ethics Commission.

**MacLand Disposal Inc., II – Evidentiary Hearing Regarding Certificate of Coverage No. R1-109 under the State Wide General Permit for a Class I Rubbish Site, Jackson County, Mississippi**

The matter before the Permit Board was a formal evidentiary hearing regarding issuance of a Certificate of Coverage under the State Wide General Permit for a Class I Rubbish Site to MacLand Disposal Inc., II ("Mac II") for its rubbish site located in Moss Point, Jackson County, Mississippi. Ms. Gayla Crowley opposed issuance of the permit coverage and requested the hearing so the Permit Board could reconsider MDEQ staff's issuance of the coverage on September 26, 2012.

The hearing officer in this matter was Deanne Saltzman, Special Assistant Attorney General with the Office of the Attorney General. The Department was represented by General Counsel Roy Furrh and Senior Attorney Lisa Ouzts. Attorneys Keith Turner and Betty Ruth Fox represented Mac II. Ms. Crowley represented herself. MDEQ submitted pre-filed direct testimony through the affidavit of William A. Warden and rebuttal testimony through the affidavits of William A. Warden and Ethan Corey Mayeu. Mac II did not submit pre-filed direct testimony but it did submit pre-filed rebuttal testimony through the affidavit of Jeffrey J. Breedlove. Ms. Crowley submitted amended pre-filed direct and amended pre-filed rebuttal testimony through her own affidavits.

As a preliminary matter, Hearing Officer Saltzman considered Ms. Crowley's Emergency Motion to Strike which she filed the day before the hearing. After hearing from Ms. Crowley and counsel from MDEQ and Mac II, Ms. Crowley did not object to including the information she initially wanted to strike, Mac II's response to MDEQ's Notice of Violation, as part of the record as long as the Notice of Violation was also part of the record.

Roy Furrh made an opening statement on behalf of MDEQ, followed by Mr. Turner on behalf of Mac II, and Ms. Crowley on her own behalf.

William Warden testified on behalf of MDEQ through his pre-filed direct and rebuttal testimony and was tendered for cross examination by Mac II and Ms. Crowley and was further questioned by the Permit Board. Ethan Mayeu also testified on behalf of MDEQ through his pre-filed rebuttal testimony and was tendered for cross-examination by Mac II and Ms. Crowley and was questioned by the Permit Board. Jeffrey Breedlove testified on behalf of Mac II through his pre-filed rebuttal testimony and was tendered for cross examination by MDEQ and Ms. Crowley and was questioned by the Permit Board. Ms. Crowley testified on her own behalf through her amended pre-filed direct testimony and amended pre-filed rebuttal testimony and was questioned by the Permit Board.


At the conclusion of all the testimony, Mr. Furrh, Mr. Turner, and Ms. Crowley made closing statements on behalf of their respective clients. MDEQ recommended that the Permit Board affirm MDEQ staff's issuance on September 26, 2012, of the Certificate of Coverage to Mac II. The matter was then presented to the Permit Board for its decision.

At the conclusion of the formal evidentiary hearing, upon motion by Mr. Lipe and seconded by Mr. Bograd, the Permit Board unanimously voted to affirm MDEQ staff's decision to issue the certificate of coverage to Mac II for its Class I rubbish site located in Jackson County, Mississippi.
