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MINING ACTIVITY IN REVIEW

In the 1987 calendar year forty-nine (49) permits were issued for a total of 1297.2 acres as follows:

- 954.3 acres of sand and gravel mining,
- 180.5 acres of borrow mining,
- 137.4 acres of limestone mining,
- 15 acres of bentonite mining, and
- 10 acres of clay mining.

Acres reclaimed and granted partial or full bond release in 1987 was as follows:

- 760.3 acres given partial (includes initial) release, and
- 420.1 acres given final (total) release.

Fifty-seven (57) Notices of Exempt Operations (site of less than 4 acres and greater than 1/4 mile from any other site) were issued for a total of 185.6 acres.

Surface mining activity in the state between April 15, 1978, the inception of the Surface Mining Law, and February 12, 1988, includes the following:

- 285 permits issued,
- 221 active permits,
- 67 permits granted partial release,
- 64 permits granted final release, and
- 391 exempt operations.

GLOSSARY

Listed and defined below are those materials mined commercially in Mississippi.

AGRICULTURAL LIME: Includes chalks and limestones from the northeast and marls and limestones from the south-central portion of the state; composed primarily of calcium carbonate (CaCO_3); pulverized and added to cropland to neutralize acidity and promote plant growth; beneficial to sandy soils which are generally low in lime content.

BALL CLAY: A light buff to gray clay with varying amounts of organic matter; high plasticity, high wet and dry strength; high firing shrinkage, and long vitrification range; used as a bonding constituent of ceramic wares; term "ball" from early English mining practice of rolling the highly plastic clay into balls weighing 30 to 50 pounds.

BENTONITE: A clay formed by the alteration of volcanic ash; color ranges from white to light green to light blue; can absorb large amounts of water which increases the volume by about 8 times; used for making refractory linings, water softening, decolorizing of oils, and thickening drilling muds.

CLAY: A rock or mineral fragment having a diameter smaller than 0.005 millimeter (0.0002 inch); used in making brick.

CRUSHED AGGREGATE: Product resulting from the artificial crushing of rocks (gravel to boulder size) after quarrying.

FOUNDRY CLAY: A plastic clay with good bonding qualities; mixed with clay to make foundry molds.

FULLER'S EARTH: A material that resembles clay but lacks the plasticity; a natural bleaching agent; due to its ability to absorb liquid, used commercially as floor absorbants (kitty litter).

GRAVEL: An unconsolidated, natural accumulation of rounded rock fragments; particles between 2 and 75 millimeters (0.08 to 3 inches); used in concrete and asphalt.

RIPRAP: Heavy, irregular rock chunks used as a foundation or retaining wall on spillways, shore protection, docks, and other areas that must resist erosion.

SAND: Loose rock fragments or particles between 0.062 and 2 millimeters (0.0025 to 0.08 inches); used in concrete.

OPERATOR OF THE YEAR



GREEN BROTHERS GRAVEL COMPANY

Green Brothers Gravel Company of Jackson, Mississippi, obtained the first Surface Mining Permit issued by the Mississippi Geological, Economic, and Topographical Survey (predecessor to the Bureau of Geology) in April 1978. Seeing a need for some type of statewide mining regulation, Green Brothers Gravel was instrumental in getting the State to adopt the Mississippi Surface Mining Law of 1978. This company receives the first Operator of the Year Award for its continuing effort to work with the State since the inception of the surface mining law.

Green Brothers Gravel currently has eight active permits, all in Copiah County, for a total of 180 acres. Of these 180 acres, 63 acres have been partially released. The first permit of five acres, also located in Copiah County, has been fully released.

The material mined in all of the permit areas is sand and gravel. In this part of Copiah County, southeast of Crystal Springs, the sand and gravel deposit varies in thickness from 25 to 75 feet and is part of the Citronelle Formation. Draglines, bulldozers, and wheel loaders dig and remove the material using a method called open pit mining. This method involves removing a two- to ten-foot layer of overburden until the top of the deposit is exposed. As the material is mined, draglines and wheel loaders load it onto trucks where it is taken either directly to the job site or sent to a wash

operation. The wash operation cleans and sorts the gravel so that it may be used as aggregate in concrete and asphalt.

During the mining operation, Green Brothers Gravel implements methods that minimize the effects of surface mining on the environment. Sediment runoff, a common problem with most mining operations, can be detrimental to nearby streams and rivers. Green Brothers Gravel avoids these problems by constructing sediment catch dams, diversion berms, and sediment settling ponds.

After all of the usable material has been mined, the area must then be reclaimed to a useful and beneficial state. This includes sloping all vertical walls to at least a 3:1 slope (3 feet horizontal for each 1 foot vertical), shaping, and planting some type of stabilizing vegetation. Green Brothers Gravel has reclaimed the 68 acres as primarily grass-covered, gently rolling terrain with several small ponds.

RECLAMATION PROJECT OF THE YEAR



AMERICAN COLLOID COMPANY

American Colloid Company, a nationwide organization with a regional office in Aberdeen, Mississippi, receives this year's award for Reclamation Project of the Year. The permit, filed by Fowlkes Contracting Company of Amory, Mississippi, is an 82-acre open-pit bentonite mine. This Reclamation Award is for a 28-acre tract within the permit area that was mined and reclaimed.

Prior to the mining, this area, a terrain of steep hills and valleys covered by scrub hardwood, was stripped of vegetation. After clearing the vegetation, scrapers and bulldozers began removing the overburden, or the material down to the top of the bentonite layer. The overburden ranges in thickness from 40 to 120 feet but, in most areas, averages 75 feet. After removing the overburden, draglines scraped up the relatively thin layer of bentonite. Bentonite, an altered volcanic ash composed primarily of montmorillonite clays, averages only six feet in thickness. This bentonite layer, enclosed in the Tombigbee Sand Member of the Eutaw Formation, was deposited approximately 75 million years ago.

Erosion control structures must be used during the mining operation to keep sediment runoff from entering and polluting nearby creeks and streams. The overburden, stockpiled for use in the reclamation, was seeded to prevent erosion and siltation. Diversion ditches constructed around the

pit diverted most of the runoff water. Water that did accumulate in the pits was pumped into local streams after the sediment settled out of suspension.

Reclamation consisted of contouring the mined area to blend in with the surrounding topography. All vertical walls were sloped and shaped while some areas required backfilling with the stockpiled overburden. Final reclamation resulted in a flat-topped plateau with a shallow catch basin on top and terraced slopes. The area was fertilized and seeded and now supports a dense grass cover which very effectively prevents erosion.

HONORABLE MENTION FOR SURFACE MINING RECLAMATION



MEMPHIS STONE & GRAVEL COMPANY

Memphis Stone & Gravel Company of Memphis, Tennessee, obtained its first Mississippi Surface Mining Permit in September 1979 for a 21-acre gravel operation in DeSoto County. Since then Memphis Stone has expanded its operations in Mississippi to include 15 active permits for a total of 347 acres. Of this total acreage, 52 acres have had a 75% bond release, 19 acres a 90% bond release, and 40 acres a 100% bond release, for a total of 111 acres which have been partially or fully released. The pit for which Memphis Stone received the Honorable Mention is a 37-acre open pit/strip mining operation for sand and gravel located in Panola County. Erosion control structures utilized during the mining operation included settling ponds, diversion berms, drainage ditches, and terraced slopes. This former gravel pit, once wooded, has been reclaimed to a gently sloping pasture.

HONORABLE MENTION FOR SURFACE MINING RECLAMATION



HARSHAW/FILTROL PARTNERSHIP (Presently Harshaw Chemical Company)

Harshaw/Filtrol Partnership of Jackson, Mississippi, obtained its first Surface Mining Permit in 1978 for a 74-acre clay mine in Monroe County. Harshaw Chemical Company currently has five permits totalling 181 acres with a 90% bond release on 17.4 acres and a 100% bond release on 52 acres, for a total of 69.4 acres being partially or fully released. The mine for which it received the Honorable Mention is a 17.4-acre open-pit clay mine in Smith County, which has a 90% bond release. This area, previously a pine forest, has been reclaimed as a gently rolling pasture with a small pond.

Harshaw/Filtrol not only reclaimed the permit area but also reclaimed an adjacent 13-acre "grandfathered" area. This 13-acre tract, mined prior to the enactment of the Surface Mining and Reclamation Law (1978), did not require reclamation. Harshaw/Filtrol should be recognized in its efforts to preserve and enhance the natural resources of Mississippi.
