**Rules of Practice and Procedure for Formal Evidentiary Hearings before the
Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board**

MDEQ Senior Attorney Lisa Ouzts presented Proposed Rules of Practice and Procedure for Formal Evidentiary Hearings before the Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board for the Board's consideration. Ms. Ouzts advised the Permit Board that the public notice of the proposed Rules was published three times between February 12 and February 26, 2015, in three Mississippi newspapers. Ms. Ouzts stated that one person submitted written comments on the proposed Rules and that she forwarded the comments to the Permit Board members prior to the Permit Board's meeting. Ms. Ouzts advised the Board that the commenter questioned why the proposed Rules were not published in the Meridian newspaper. Ms. Ouzts advised the Board that although the public notice requirements would have been met by publishing the proposed Rules in a newspaper with statewide circulation, MDEQ published the proposed Rules in the Commercial Appeal to reach the northern part of the state, the Sun Herald to reach the southern part of the state, and the Clarion Ledger to reach the entire state. Ms. Ouzts pointed out that the commenter, a Meridian resident, actually saw the public notice that was published in the Clarion Ledger. Ms. Ouzts stated MDEQ staff's recommendation that the Permit Board adopt the proposed Rules.

Upon motion by Mr. David Snodgrass to accept staff's recommendation to adopt the Rules, seconded by Mr. Mike Bograd, the Permit Board voted unanimously to accept staff's recommendation and adopt the Rules.

Construction Building Material Branch

Oscar Renda Contracting, Biloxi, North Facility:

Michael Griffith, of MDEQ's Environmental Permits Division ("EPD"), presented Oscar Renda Construction's Notice of Intent for coverage under the Ready Mix Concrete General Permit (Coverage #MSG110313).

Oscar Renda Contracting proposes to construct a new 100-cubic yard per hour ready-mix concrete plant in Biloxi, Mississippi. Oscar Renda submitted a Notice of Intent for coverage under the Multi-Media Ready-Mix Concrete General Permit to MDEQ which deemed the Notice of Intent complete. Mr. Griffith advised the Permit Board that Ready-Mix facilities are considered to be minor sources of air emissions.

The application process requires an applicant to notify contiguous

landowners, via certified-return receipt requested mail, of a proposed Ready Mix facility. As a result of this notification, EPD received three letters of objection or concern from contiguous landowners. The letters expressed concerns with storm water discharges, wastewater processing, and declining property values. EPD

replied to these letters of concern on April 6, 2015, to address the environmental issues raised by the landowners. Mr. Tony Morrow spoke on behalf of the permit applicant. Mr. Morrow advised the Board that the proposed facility was only a temporary facility and that the facility would be closed upon completion of the project. No one addressed the Permit Board in opposition to the proposed facility.

MDEQ's South Regional Office inspected the proposed site on March 4, 2015. The results of the inspection revealed no residential or recreational areas within 150 feet. Therefore, MDEQ staff determined that the siting criteria would be met.

On motion by Jim Lipe and seconded by Jan Boyd, the Permit Board voted to accept the staff's recommendation to issue the permit.

Agriculture Branch

JJ Farm:

Tracy Tompkins of MDEQ's Environmental Permits Division presented JJ Farm's application for reissuance of coverage under AFO General Permit # MSG201044 and issuance of Storm Water Coverage under Storm Water Coverage Permit # MSR106830.

Hoang Nguyen (JJ Farm) proposes to construct and operate eight poultry houses, with a total of 296,000 broilers, in Newton County, Mississippi. Mr. Nguyen submitted a Dry Litter Poultry Notice of Intent (NOI), a Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP), a Large Construction Notice of Intent (LCNOI) and a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) seeking issuance under the Multimedia Dry Litter Poultry Animal Feeding Operation General Permit No. MSG201044 and Construction Storm Water No. MSR106830 on January 29, 2015.

Mr. Nguyen sent contiguous landowner notifications as required by the permit. MDEQ received four letters of concern. MDEQ's regional office performed site inspections on February 18, 2015, and MDEQ's Environmental Permits Division performed site inspections on March 27, 2015. MDEQ noted that the facility was not in compliance with the siting criteria; however, the applicant

obtained waivers of the siting criteria from all landowners who owned properties within the buffer zone. MDEQ received objections from a mother and daughter who resided outside of the buffer zone. The objectors were not at the Permit Board meeting and no one present at the meeting spoke in opposition of the project. Mr. Nguyen was in attendance but did not speak. Ms. Tomkins recommended that the Permit Board issue the coverages to JJ Farm based on technical merits of the Notices of Intent, the CNMP, the SWPPP, and buffer zone waivers.

On motion by David Snodgrass and seconded by Jim Lipe, the Permit Board voted to accept the staff's recommendation to issue the permit.

Solid Waste Management and Mining

Charlie Bock of the Environmental Permits Division presented information regarding renewals of Wastewater Pretreatment Permit, MSP091106, NPDES Storm Water Permit, MSS048658, Title V Air Permit, 2200-00025 and modification of Solid Waste Permit, SW0560010436 of the Pine Belt Regional Solid Waste Management Authority.

Mr. Bock stated that there was a public hearing regarding the reissuance of these permits on March 31, 2015 and there were no comments received. There were no visitors in attendance in opposition to the renewals of any of the permits. Staff has reviewed these applications recommends the reissuance of these permits.

On motion by Jan Boyd and seconded by Jim Hoffmann, the Permit Board voted to accept the staff's recommendation to reissue all permits.

Municipal and Private Facilities

West Rankin Utility Authority Wastewater Treatment Facility, Issuance of NPDES Permit MSO061743, Rankin County, Mississippi

MDEQ staff presented West Rankin Utility Authority's ("WRUA") application for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") permit for a proposed wastewater treatment facility to be located in Rankin County, Mississippi. WRUA, a regional authority created by local and private legislation, is composed of the Cities of Richland, Pearl, Brandon, and Flowood and the Pearl River Water Supply District, the state owned facilities at Whitfield, and the Jackson-Evers International Airport. The City of Jackson's Savanna Street wastewater treatment system currently treats and disposes of wastewater collected and transmitted by WRUA. Roy Furrh, MDEQ's General Counsel, advised the Permit Board that MDEQ sent a number of documents—submitted by Jackson, WRUA, and MDEQ—to the Board for its consideration prior to the meeting. Bradley Crain, speaking on behalf of MDEQ staff, advised the Board that WRUA submitted an anti-degradation report along with its permit application as required by the regulations governing NPDES permits. Mr. Crain also advised the Board that if it issued a permit as requested, WRUA would be in compliance with MDEQ's regulatory requirements including the anti-degradation policy.

Attorney Keith Turner addressed the Permit Board on behalf of WRUA. Mr. Turner stated that WRUA was a regional utility authority and that the regulation encouraging consolidation of wastewater treatment services did not require two regional authorities to consolidate. Mr. Turner stated WRUA's concerns with the rising costs associated with sending its wastewater to Jackson for treatment and noted persistent problems with the Savanna Street treatment system. Mr. Turner noted that Jackson was under an Agreed Order with MDEQ and EPA to remedy the problems with the Savanna Street system and that cost estimates for fixing the Savanna Street system keep changing. Concerned that a disproportionate amount of

costs associated with bringing the Savanna Street system would be passed on to WRUA's customers, WRUA decided to build its own treatment facility.

Jackson Mayor Tony Yarber acknowledged to the Permit Board that Jackson has problems with its water and wastewater systems but stated that Jackson's new leadership has been making plans to address the problems. Mayor Yarber stated Jackson's willingness to address WRUA's concerns with rising costs and expressed his concerns that if WRUA were allowed to build its own treatment plant and treat its own wastewater, the loss of revenue Jackson would experience would negatively impact its Jackson customers. Mayor Yarber also expressed concern with negative impacts to the environment. Kishia Powell, Jackson's Director of Public Works, stated that should WRUA cease sending its wastewater to Jackson for treatment, costs to Jackson's customers would increase by 25 percent. Ms. Powell stated that since her tenure as Jackson's Public Works Director, Jackson has designated a team of experts to address Jackson's persistent water and wastewater issues. Attorney Chris Pomeroy, speaking on behalf of Jackson, stated that the applicable regulations encouraged regionalization of wastewater treatment; Mr. Pomeroy also stated that WRUA's anti-degradation report was inadequate.

After all parties made their presentations, the Permit Board voted to go into closed session to discuss whether to go into executive session. After going back into open session, the Permit Board stated that it did not vote to go into executive session. Chairperson Leslie Royals then asked if any of the Permit Board had a motion. On motion by Mr. Bograd, seconded by Mr. Jim Lipe, the Permit Board unanimously voted to issue the NPDES permit to WRUA.


OTHER BUSINESS


