In response to your e-mail of December 14, 2010, Covington Civil & Environmental, LLC, on behalf of the Mississippi State Port Authority, is pleased to submit the revised Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for the subject site. This plan has been revised to address the time before disturbed areas need to be temporarily or permanently seeded. As you stated in your e-mail, due to new permit requirements that will be coming out shortly, the time period before a disturbed area is seeded should be **14 days** instead of the 30 days that were shown on our original SWPPP submittal.

We are attaching our revised SWPPP. Pages 3, 4, P3 and P4 have been revised to reflect the 14 days. The revision on pages 3 and 4 are shown in bold and underlined.

It is our understanding that this revision is all that is required before a Large Construction Storm Water General Permit can be issued for this project.
