MDEQ Lifts Beach Closure for Station 12A in Biloxi

(JACKSON, Miss.) -- The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), through its Beach Monitoring Program, lifted a beach closure Saturday for the following beach monitoring station that was closed July 15:

- **Station 12A – Biloxi West Central Beach -- from Travia Avenue to Iberville Drive.**

Water samples at this station show the area has attained acceptable bacteria levels. The Gulf Coast Research Laboratory, which performs water sampling of the Mississippi Gulf Coast beaches for MDEQ, notifies the agency when an area returns to acceptable levels and safe conditions.
