**E-Manifest Launch is Coming**

The Federal e-Manifest System for hazardous wastes will launch nationwide on June 30, 2018. Once the e-Manifest system goes live, hazardous waste receiving facilities will be tasked with submitting manifests in accordance with regulations and to remit payments in accordance with the approved fee schedule. These tasks can be accomplished by submitting manifests directly in the e-Manifest system, uploading manifest data from an industry system, submitting a PDF copy of a paper manifest, mailing in a hard copy manifest, or conducting a hybrid process which incorporates a paper manifest which transitions to electronic manifest with the transporter. Every handler of hazardous waste may consider registering to use the e--Manifest system or may continue to utilize paper manifests. Electronic manifesting will require a CROMERR-compliant signature process. The e-Manifest regulations are not delegable to the States; therefore, the U.S. EPA is charged with collecting manifest payments and for overseeing compliance related to non-payment. The final rule contains fee estimates for the various manifest types that are reflected in the table below:

**E-Manifest in Mississippi**

All industry participants which intend to submit manifests electronically are required to register in RCRAInfo through the “MyRCRAid” application. Mississippi is working towards obtaining the “MyRCRAid” privileges from EPA in order to approve system users which do business in Mississippi. We anticipate this process being concluded no later than May 1, 2018.
