Dear Messrs. McKercher and Lightsey:

Pursuant to Section 4.A. of the Agreed Order No. 6789-17 (the "Agreed Order") entered on September 11, 2017, First Environment, Inc., on behalf of EnPro Industries, Inc., submits the enclosed Corrective Action Work Plan ("CAWP"), Rev. 2, regarding the former Holley Automotive/Coltec Industries Facility located in Water Valley, Mississippi and known downgradient plume area.

The CAWP submitted to the MDEQ on November 10, 2017 was revised on January 12, 2018 ("CAWP, Rev. 1") to address the MDEQ's comments in the November 29, 2017 and December 15, 2017 meetings. On February 21, 2018, MDEQ requested, via electronic mail, additional information regarding the CAWP, Rev. 1. On March 14, 2018, First Environment responded to MDEQ's comments. Subsequently, the CAWP, Rev. 1, was discussed in April 12, 2018 and May 9, 2018 meetings with the MDEQ. The enclosed CAWP, Rev. 2, was revised to address the MDEQ's comments. The enclosed CAWP, Rev. 2, also includes a revised schedule for the CAWP implementation (Appendix C). Subject to the MDEQ's approval of the CAWP, Rev. 2, First Environment expects to commence implementation in early June 2018.

As noted in Section 1.1 of the enclosed CAWP, as with any corrective action work plan and associated investigative and remediation activities, it may be necessary to augment and/or revise the proposed remedial approach. Any additional work will be done with the continued oversight and direction of MDEQ as contemplated in the Agreed Order and as governed by Miss. Code §17-17-54.
