#### **New Contractor Certifications**

Added Certified UST Technician which means a person who has been certified by the Department to perform testing and non-invasive repairs to UST systems

Added Certified Cathodic Protection Tester which means a person who has been certified by the Department to have successfully completed a Department approved 3<sup>rd</sup> party examination to test Cathodic protection on a UST system

## **Defined Non-invasive repair**

Added a definition of non-invasive repair to specify what work can or cannot be completed by specific UST certified contractor types.

# **New General Requirements for UST Certified Contractors**

Implementation date of six months from date of regulation adoption where certification will be required for non-invasive repairs.

Requires contractor's UST equipment to be maintained, calibrated, and repaired in accordance with manufacture requirements

Requires contractor to notify the tank owner/operator in writing whenever testing reveals a failure and notify the tank owner/operator of their responsibility to notify MDEQ

Certified contractor shall be responsible for maintaining all applicable certifications for installing and testing specific equipment.

Requires all UST equipment to be installed, altered, or non-invasively repaired in accordance with manufacture requirements.

#### **New Experience Requirements**

Certified Installation Contractor – 2 years \* Certified Permanent Closure Contractor – 2 years\* Note\* unless otherwise approved by MDEQ Certified Cathodic Protection Technician – 6 months\* Certified UST Technician – 6 months\*

# **Updated Continuing Education**

Added requirements for continuing education for the new tester certification and allowed a contractor to be only an installer, if requested, which reduces continuing education hours from 16 hours to 8 hours

Updated or added definitions for:

- Critical junctures
- Employee
- Permanent Closure
- Sampling
- Test or Testing

Clarification of general requirements for certified contractors.
