As indicated in our November 9, 2017 SSDS Effectiveness Evaluation Workplan (“Workplan”), approved by the MDEQ on November 13, 2017, First Environment relocated the sump adjacent to the Maintenance Room to a new permanent location at the south wall of the Plant. The sump relocation was completed on Thursday, January 11, 2018. The construction of the new sump is consistent with the construction diagram attached to the Workplan. It is our understanding that BorgWarner will decommission the old sump and commence operation of the new sump on Monday, January 15, 2018.


