On motion by Jennifer Wittmann and seconded by Dennis Riecke, the Permit Board voted to approve the following surface mining permit transfers: (David Dockery abstained)

Desoto Services, LLC	P89-022T; P93-051T; P04-006AT	Harrison
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Desoto Services, LLC, requests the permits P89-022T, P93-051T, and P04-006AT be transferred to D.W. Lamey Fill and Trucking, Inc. D.W. Lamey Fill and Trucking, Inc. have provided the proper bonding and transfer forms. Desoto Services, LLC requests that its bond be returned. The new permit numbers for D.W. Lamey Fill and Trucking, Inc. will be P89-022T1, P93-051T1, and P04-006AAT.

Surface Mining Permit Modification with additional acreage and reissuance and modification of coverage under the mining storm water general permit.

D & E Construction Co., Inc.	P95-071 and MSR320485	Lauderdale
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D & E Construction proposes to open pit mine 14 additional acres to a depth of 20.5 feet for borrow material. This is in addition to the previously permitted 12 acres at the same location which would make a total of 26 acres. D & E applied for modification of its Surface Mining Permit and reissuance and modification of its coverage under Large Construction Stormwater General Permit. Ron Porter with MDEQ's Office of Geology stated that sediment and erosion from the mine would be controlled by settling ponds and diversion berms. Reclamation of the mine would consist of 3 to 1 grassed and reforested slopes. MDEQ received one letter from an adjoining landowner, Dr. Richard Vise, objecting to the proposed expansion. Dr. Vise objected because one of the two lakes on his property has been receiving sediment from the mine. Dr. Vise stated that he did not object to D & E mining material as long as it can do so without impacting his lake. D & E agreed to install additional controls to reduce sediment from leaving the site.

Dr. Vise was present and made comments to the Permit Board. He stated that he had proposed that D & E lease his lake, use it as a sediment basin, and restore it once they completed mining. Florance Bass, Manager of MDEQ's Storm Water Branch stated that the lake was a water of the state and could not be used as a sediment basin. She stated MDEQ had inspected the site and noted there were issues with sediment leaving the site. She stated that D & E installed additional controls requested by MDEQ and that a follow-up inspection showed that sedimentation had been reduced. Mr. Dane Ethridge stated on behalf of D & E that he believed they had put all the measures in place that they can but does not think there is a way to completely stop sediment from leaving the site. He stated that D & E had tried to work with Dr. Vise and had discussed alternatives such as leasing the lake from Dr. Vise or going in 50-50 to clean the lake.

MDEQ recommended issuance of the surface mining permit modification and of the storm water coverage.

Dennis Riecke made a motion to approve Staff's recommendation, but his motion did not receive a second.

Subsequently, on motion by Dennis Riecke and seconded by Les Herrington, the Permit Board voted to allow more time for both parties to work out among themselves a mutual agreement and bring the matter back before the Permit Board for its consideration at a later date. Mr. Dockery abstained.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Dusty Myers, MDEQ's Office of Land and Water, presented an overview of MDEQ's Dam Safety Permitting Process to the Permit Board.

MDEQ's General Counsel, Roy Furrh, informed the Permit Board that the evidentiary hearing scheduled for December 11, 2018, regarding a request for modification of C. F. Gollott & Son Seafood, Inc.'s NPDES permit has been postponed.

Mr. Furrh also informed the Permit Board that an evidentiary hearing has been scheduled for the Le Poultry matter for the Permit Board meeting on April 9, 2019. MDEQ will continue to work on the Renaissance Water Quality Certification request for revocation made by Steve Maloney which was denied by the Executive Director of MDEQ and noted on the Permit Board's minutes at the October 9, 2018, meeting. Mr. Maloney has appealed that Executive Director's decision directly to the Chancery Court of Madison County rather than seeking administrative relief through an evidentiary hearing before the Permit Board. Staff will be updating Permit Board members as this matter progresses.

CONFIRMATION OF THE NEXT REGULAR PERMIT BOARD MEETING

Chair Jim Hoffmann confirmed that the next Regular Meeting will be held on December 11, 2018.


MEETING ADJOURNED
