**Surface Mining Permit Modification with additional acreage and recoverage and modification of coverage under the mining storm water, dewatering, and no discharge general NPDES permit.**

D & E Construction Co., Inc.                      P95-071 and MSR320485                      Lauderdale

At the Permit Board's November 13, 2018 meeting, staff for the Office of Geology stated that D & E was applying for a modification to its existing Surface Mining Permit (No. P95-071) to allow it to mine an additional 14 acres, and for recoverage and modification of its coverage under the Mining Storm Water, Dewatering and No Discharge General NPDES Permit (No. MSR320485). At the November meeting, the Permit Board voted to allow more time for D & E and Dr. Richard Vise, an adjacent landowner, to work out among themselves a mutual agreement and bring the matter back before the Board for later consideration. At the December meeting, Staff of the Office of Geology noted the parties were unable to work out an agreement. MDEQ's James Matheny reminded the Permit Board that the modification would allow D & E to mine an additional 14 acres to a 25-foot depth for borrow material.

MDEQ's Florance Bass stated that D & E was seeking recoverage and modification under the Mining Storm Water, Dewatering and No Discharge General NPDES Permit to allow continued operation including reclamation activities in the authorized mine area. Specifically, MDEQ received D & E's recoverage request on June 26, 2018, an updated form on October 3, 2018, its modification request on February 21, 2018, and an updated form on August 17, 2018. Ms. Bass stated that Dr. Vise submitted comments during the public comment period for the Department of Geology's Surface Mining Permit opposing the proposed expansion. MDEQ's Office of Geology originally went to public notice on April 11, 2018, and issued a new public notice in September 2018 to address deficiencies in the previous notice. Dr. Vise submitted additional comments during the new public notice period. Dr. Vise expressed concerns with storm water from the mine draining into a downstream lake located on property in which he holds ownership interest which caused the lake to be muddy.

MDEQ conducted a compliance evaluation inspection of the site in June of 2018. MDEQ noted that work was occurring outside of the permitted area with no storm water controls. D & E ceased all work in the area and updated the permit applications to reflect changes in the overall mining acreage. During this visit, it was noted that Dr. Vise had an interest in property which includes a lake that is located downstream of the mining area. MDEQ again met with D & E in July 2018 and voiced concerns about the controls. As a result, D & E submitted a new storm water pollution prevention plan ("SWPPP") with its modification form in August 2018. After reviewing the SWPPP and modification request, and after an October 2018 site visit, MDEQ requested D & E to implement additional storm water controls. These controls included installation of a drainage riser with skimmer to be incorporated into the plan to allow utilization of the full volume of the sedimentation basin and allow increased residence time of storm water to allow settling of sediments. As of late October 2018, MDEQ staff observed that all of the implemented controls appeared to be in good working order. MDEQ inspected the site again after the Permit Board's November 13, 2018, meeting to evaluate the working condition of the controls. The inspection revealed controls appeared to be in good working order. Because D & E and Dr. Vise were

unable to reach an agreement, D & E requested that the Board consider this matter at its December meeting.

Dr. Vise made a presentation to the Permit Board. As part of his presentation, he submitted photographs of the two lakes on the property which he has interest contending that the lake downstream of the mine site was muddy and the other lake was clear. Dr. Vise stated that D & E offered to clean out the muddy lake and split the costs with Dr. Vise 50/50. Dr. Vise stated he did not want to clean out the lake while mining of the D & E site continues. General Counsel Roy Furrh advised Dr. Vise of the Permit Board's limited jurisdiction and stated that while the Permit Board could consider D & E's compliance history related to the proposed storm water recoverage and modification, the Board did not have jurisdiction to determine the amount of damages to Dr. Vise caused by D & E's operations.

Kevin Thompson, a professional engineer, addressed the Permit Board on behalf of D & E. Mr. Thompson stated that D & E contacted him regarding the proposed expansion in December 2017. He indicated that he proposed installation of an additional sediment pond with the expansion. He stated that any areas not being actively mined would be revegetated. He indicated that the additional sediment pond is larger than what is required. He mentioned that the need to mine the site is project driven and D & E was committed to maintain compliance. Steve Bailey, who is in MDEQ's Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Division, mentioned that the sediment pond exceeds MDEQ requirements; specifically, according to the calculations of D & E's engineer, the pond is double the capacity than what is required. He stated that if additional controls are necessary, MDEQ would require them. Ms. Bass pointed out that the storm water coverage also governs reclamation activities; thus, she recommended issuance of the re-coverage and modification.

Permit Board members asked questions to MDEQ staff, Dr. Vise and representative of D & E and considered the responses.

At the end of the presentation, the Permit Board allowed a brief recess for Dr. Vise and Mr. Etheridge with D & E to further discuss a possible resolution. After the recess, Dr. Vise stated he thought it would be better to delay the Permit Board's vote to give him and D & E additional time to resolve this matter.

MDEQ recommended issuance of the surface mining permit modification and recoverage and modification of the storm water coverage.

Upon motion by Les Herrington and seconded by Dennis Riecke, the Permit Board voted to accept the staff's recommendation to issue the surface mining permit modification and to issue recoverage and modification of the storm water coverage. (David Dockery abstained)

#### **OTHER BUSINESS**

MDEQ's General Counsel, Roy Furrh reminded the Permit Board that an evidentiary hearing has been scheduled for the Le Poultry matter for the Permit Board meeting on April 9, 2019 following the Permit Board agenda.


#### **CONFIRMATION OF THE NEXT REGULAR PERMIT BOARD MEETING**
