

**MINUTES OF THE MISSISSIPPI ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PERMIT BOARD
HELD IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 13, 2019**

The Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board held a meeting in the Commission Hearing Room of the Department of Environmental Quality, located at 515 East Amite Street, on August 13, 2019. Roy Furrh, General Counsel for MDEQ, was present as legal counsel. Dennis Riecke moved to adopt the revised version of the minutes of the July 9, 2019, meeting that included suggested edits that he previously submitted and also to include a revision to those suggested edits to change the comment period listed from a 51-day to a 61-day comment period. Chris Hawkins seconded the Motion and the Permit Board voted to approve the revisions. Next, Chris Hawkins motioned and Dennis Riecke seconded to approve the full body of the minutes of the July 9, 2019, meeting as edited and the Permit Board voted to approve the minutes.

**Mississippi State Port Authority of Gulfport – North Port Property
Harrison County, Mississippi
WQC2018036
NPDES Construction Stormwater Coverage MSR107890**

The Mississippi State Port Authority (Authority) applied for a Section 401 Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. § 1341) Water Quality Certification (WQC2018036) to conduct regulated activities in waters of the state for the creation of a rail spur, paved storage lots, high security fencing, site lighting, electrical duct bank, detention basin, and drainage swales. The purpose of this project is to provide a storage lot for equipment and cargo in support of Department of Defense (DOD) shipments. The Authority also submitted a Large Construction Notice of Intent (LCNOI) and an associated Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) on December 17, 2018, to obtain coverage under Mississippi's Large Construction Storm Water General Permit for the proposed project. The LCNOI indicated the proposed project would disturb approximately 16 acres. The Department deemed the LCNOI and SWPPP complete and adequate in addressing storm water discharges from the project site. Some of the storm water controls proposed during the construction phase include, but are not limited to, silt fences, a sedimentation basin, and wattles.

Florance Bass, Manager of MDEQ's 401 and Stormwater Branch, stated that the proposed project, known as the North Port Property, consists of approximately 16 acres, of which 3.15 acres are freshwater wetlands. The proposed project site is located approximately two miles north of the existing Port of Gulfport in waters adjacent to Turkey Creek and Brickyard Bayou in the City of Gulfport, Harrison County, Mississippi. The proposed project site is bordered on the north by vacant property, on the west by vacant property and 34th Avenue, and on the south by 33rd Street. The Mid-South Rail Line/Kansas City Southern (KCS) line runs adjacent and parallel to the eastern boundary of the site.

The North Port Property has been highly disturbed and is located at the site of the former Gulfport Fertilizer Company. This site was found to have lead and arsenic contamination in soil and groundwater and a 2009 Corrective Action Plan (2009 CAP) governs the site. Pursuant to the 2009 CAP, the contaminated eastern portion of property was capped with 10-inch layer of clay. The eastern portion of the site will be fenced off. The 2009 CAP also requires semi-annual groundwater sampling; results of the sampling conducted thus far indicate that elevated levels of arsenic and lead have not migrated beyond the limits of the designated groundwater contamination area located in the vicinity of the capped area. The proposed project will be located south of the contaminated capped area; the capped area will not be

disturbed. One groundwater monitoring well, which is located near the southeastern edge of the proposed storage lot, will remain on site but the cover of the well will be changed to better protect the well.

Ms. Bass stated that the proposed project would result in the placement of fill material in 3.15 acres of jurisdictional wetlands. Thus, the proposed project requires a Clean Water Act Section 404 permit from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) and a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) from the Department. The project also requires a Coastal Zone consistency from the Department of Marine Resources. The applicant will mitigate for the unavoidable losses of state waters by purchasing credits from an approved wetland mitigation bank. A functional assessment of the wetlands was conducted in order to establish an ecological value of the wetlands and to form a quantitative basis for determining mitigation requirements. The number of credits required was determined using the results of the Wetland Rapid Assessment Procedure.

The application for Section 401 WQC is the Joint Public Notice, which began on June 4, 2018, and includes all subsequent revisions. As part of the public notice procedures for this type of activity, a copy of the joint public notice was provided to the adjacent property owners. During the joint public notice period, the Department received a letter objecting to the project citing concerns with soil contamination and questioning whether there were feasible alternatives. The Department held a public hearing on May 9, 2019, at the Good Deeds Community Center in Gulfport, Mississippi, in order to gather additional information to be used in considering the action before the Permit Board. Issues raised during the public hearing included the following: procedures for hosting public hearings, water dependency, feasible alternatives, impacts to wetlands, cumulative impacts, soil and water contamination, stormwater runoff, flood conditions, impact to the community, environmental justice considerations, cultural resources, and job creation.

The Department provided the following documents for the Board to review prior to its meeting: the joint public notice; a copy of the public comments; the public hearing notice; a copy of the transcript of the public hearing; a Response to Comments document developed by staff; a draft of the certification rationale addressing the decision factors for a Water Quality Certification and special conditions as part of certification issuance; and a draft of the proposed Section 401 WQC.

The Permit Board invited comments regarding the WQC. Senator Deborah Dawkins, State Senator from District 48, West Harrison County stated that this project falls within her district. Senator Dawkins was concerned with environmental "injustice" to the residents of the North Gulfport area which is a historical area where residents did not, according to Senator Dawkins, historically have a choice but to live there. She stated her concern that the capped portion of the site would harm the environment if disturbed and was concerned about potential hurricanes. She also stated concerns that property values in the area would decline because of the proposed project. Commentators from the community, Mr. Glen Cogg, Ms. Rose Story, Mr. John Johnson, and Ms. Mattie Grubbs, expressed concerns with flooding; runoff of contaminated materials from the capped portion of the site; nuisance issues associated with the rail and truck traffic; feasible alternatives; and environmental justice issues.

Mr. John Webb, the Authority's Director of Engineering, was present at the meeting and was joined by Mr. Bruce Newton with Digital Engineering, the design firm that designed the proposed project. Mr. Webb stated that the Authority planned to use about 10 acres of the extreme southeast corner of its property that is adjacent to the KCS railroad for the proposed project. Mr. Webb stated that the Authority is one of twelve designated strategic national ports in the United States and, as such, must provide designated "lay down areas" with twenty-four hours' notice for mobilization requiring the use of the port. Mr. Webb stated cargo is offloaded from the ship, transferred to truck or rail, and shipped out or vice versa. The proposed project area will not be used for storage. Mr. Webb stated the materials coming into and leaving the proposed project site would be contained in shipping containers or would be in military vehicles. Mr. Webb indicated there would be no contaminated materials coming into or going out of the project site. In response to the Permit Board's questions, Mr. Webb stated the Seabee Base was not a viable alternative site for the following reasons: existing rail spurs would need to be upgraded because they had not been used for a long time; the Seabee Base is highly congested; is specific to the Navy; and the aluminum and box site are now huge warehouses where piles of aluminum are stored. Conversely, the proposed project site has rail adjacent to the property to accommodate movement of equipment in and out of the Port. The proposed site is immediately adjacent to the rail spur which is the rail line and will be pulling a spur off of that line to provide rail car loading and unloading capabilities. Mr. Webb stated the Authority has studied this proposed project for years and the current design and concept will support the DOD initiative while causing the least amount of environmental impact. Mr. Webb confirmed the proposed project site has complied with local zoning requirements.

Permit Board Member Dennis Riecke asked if the proposed project is water dependent and, if not, whether the Corps would allow destruction of wetlands. Ms. Bass stressed that the matter before them is a Water Quality Certification. She stated that the Corps has additional permitting requirements outside of the Department's Section 401 requirements that the Corps would need to address. Thus, whether the proposed project is water dependent is outside the scope of the Department's Section 401 WQC review. Ms. Bass stated the Corps would address water dependency in its review of the Section 404 application.

Mr. Jay Liu, Engineer in training with the Department's Groundwater Assessment and Remediation Division, advised the Board that the site is currently being monitored and that the level of contamination at the referenced monitoring well had been below the target remediation goals for approximately five years. Mr. Liu stated there were deed restrictions in place that restrict use of the capped area and that the area may not be used without first obtaining permission from the Department.

Ms. Bass stated that the Corp is the federal permitting agency responsible for responding to environmental justice issues. However, the Department also addressed environmental justice by coordinating with the Department's Office of Community Engagement which recommended the Department hold a public hearing and a public information session to allow the community to ask the Authority questions, to see what the project was, and to have a hearing to submit their comments and address those comments. The Department held the public hearing and information session on May 9, 2019, in Gulfport, Mississippi. The Authority presented the project to the community and answered questions before the public hearing commenced.

Ms. Bass stated applicants for Water Quality Certifications must address eleven review factors which the Department and Permit Board consider in determining whether to issue or deny certification. She also stated the Department has a policy to deny certification in the presence of certain factors unless the applicant takes appropriate measures to eliminate unreasonable degradation and irreparable harm to waters of the state. She stated the Authority adequately addressed the review factors and that the draft rationale presented to the Permit Board addressed each of the review and denial factors.

Mr. Webb stated there may be some rail cars come in on a monthly basis on the KCS train line which is adjacent to the site: at least two full trains go by the site every day. The Authority will stop the train and pull off five to seven cars at a time, unload the cargo on the ground, and/or take cargo off the ground, put it back on a flat car and take them out. The use is going to be fairly minimal but the Authority's agreement with DOD requires the Authority to make ten acres readily available within twenty-four hours' notice.

In response to the Permit Board's preference for the Authority to purchase mitigation credits within the Turkey Creek watershed, Ms. Bass stated the Permit Board has required project applicants to exhaust all opportunities for mitigation to occur within the project water shed first.

Staff recommended issuance of the Section 401 Water Quality Certification with conditions and further recommended issuance of coverage under the Large Construction Storm Water General Permit. Mr. Riecke initially moved to issue the Water Quality Certification only after the Department receives confirmation the applicant has obtained mitigation credits from an approved mitigation bank within the Turkey Creek watershed or, if credits are not available within the Turkey Creek watershed, credits must be obtained from an approved mitigation bank within the watershed or 8-digit HUC code of the project within the Mississippi Coastal Streams Basin. Mr. Riecke withdrew his motion after being informed that the applicant must first obtain a permit from the Corps before it may purchase mitigation credits and the water quality certification is a prerequisite to obtaining a Corps permit.

Ms. Jennifer Wittmann then moved to approve the staff's recommendation to issue the Section 401 Water Quality Certification WQC2018036 and the stormwater coverage contingent upon the applicant's purchase of mitigation credits within the Turkey Creek Watershed or that the applicant exhaust all efforts to insure that mitigation takes place within the watershed and, if mitigation cannot be completed within the watershed, that the applicant must submit written justification to the Department explaining why. The Applicant would then be required to purchase mitigation credits within the eight-digit HUC of the Turkey Creek Watershed. Dennis Riecke seconded the motion and the Permit voted to accept the staff's recommendation with the contingency to issue the WQC.

Upon motion by Dennis Riecke and seconded by Chris Hawkins the Permit Board also voted to accept the staff's recommendation to issue the Large Construction Stormwater Coverage.

Buffer Zone Variance Request - Auburn Apartments LLC, Guru Properties

Lee County, Mississippi

NPDES MS0062499

Mr. Bradley Crain, Chief of the Municipal and Private Facilities Branch of MDEQ's Environmental Permit Division, advised the Permit Board that Auburn Apartments LLC requested a buffer zone variance regarding proposed NPDES permit # MS0062499. Mr. Crain stated that the only matter currently before the Permit Board was the variance request and not the permit issuance. On April 4, 2019, Auburn Apartments LLC applied for an NPDES permit to allow it to discharge effluent from a sewer treatment system that will serve an apartment complex located on Road 1562 in Lee County, Mississippi. Mr. Crain stated the treatment system is designed to treat wastewater biologically by means of an Ecopod treatment system followed by chlorine disinfection. The permit would allow for a discharge of 15,000 gallons per day of treated wastewater into a ditch thence into Tulip Creek. The applicant submitted the buffer zone variance request for the Permit Board's consideration due to the treatment facility's proposed location on the applicant's property. Specifically, the proposed location of the treatment system does not comply with the 150-foot buffer zone siting criteria requirement to the adjoining property lines as required by applicable regulations. The treatment system as proposed is less than 150 feet from two adjoining property lines. First, the proposed location is 10 feet from property to the east owned by Mr. Willis and Mrs. Mary Richey. Second, the proposed location is 10 feet from

property to the south owned by Mr. George and Mrs. Sandra Parada. These adjoining property owners would not grant buffer zone waivers to the permit applicant. Therefore, Auburn Apartments LLC requested a variance to allow it to place the treatment system 10-feet from surrounding property lines which is the minimum buffer allowed by regulation. The regulations give the Permit Board authority to consider requests for exception to or variances from the buffer requirements upon sufficient proof that the affected property owners within the buffer zone have had timely and sufficient notice of the proposed facility.

MDEQ received the variance request on July 10, 2019. On July 16, 2019, MDEQ sent a certified letter to each adjoining landowner detailing the variance request and notifying them of the date when the request will be presented to the Permit Board. MDEQ confirmed that the adjoining landowners received the notification. The Permit Board was provided the variance request, a drawing showing the location of the treatment unit and the adjoining property, and a copy of the notification letters to review before the meeting. Mr. Crain stated that variance requests were solely within the Permit Board's discretion; thus, MDEQ staff did not have a recommendation regarding the request.

Mr. Tommy Dabbs, with Dabbs Engineering, presented the variance request on behalf of Auburn Apartments LLC. He stated the treatment system was composed of concrete, was located underground, and was enclosed with a fence. Auburn Apartments LLC had previously been granted an easement by Mr. Richey, one of the adjoining landowners, to run the effluent pipe across Mr. Richey's property to the discharge point; thus, Mr. Dabbs stated Auburn Apartments LLC did not believe the 150-foot buffer requirement would be an issue. He stated that if Auburn Apartments LLC had to comply with the 150-foot buffer requirement, it would have to move the treatment system closer to the apartments. Mr. Dabbs stated before Auburn Apartments LLC purchased the apartments, there was untreated sewage. He also stated Auburn Apartments LLC did not have enough property to install an onsite system such as a spray field; thus, Auburn Apartments LLC needed a NPDES permit to allow it to discharge its treated wastewater offsite.

Ms. Sandra Richey stated her opposition to the variance request to the Permit Board. Ms. Richey stated her father owns the property and granted the easement for the pipe but she did not believe the easement was properly obtained. Attorney Thomas McElroy stated he prepared the easement documents and, at the time the easements were granted, the affected landowners knew where Auburn Apartments LLC planned to place the treatment system. Ms. Richey stated Auburn Apartments, LLC had already installed the treatment system before receiving a variance or permit.

Mr. Simon Bocuretsion, the owner of Auburn Apartments LLC, stated Auburn Apartments LLC consulted with MDEQ and followed the rules. He further stated Ms. Richey knew where the treatment system would be located.

General Counsel Roy Furrh advised the Permit Board regarding the factors it could consider in determining whether to grant a variance request. Specifically, Mr. Furrh stated the Board could consider the following: whether a person and/or facility moves within the buffer zone of a treatment facility previously approved by the Permit Board; the type of land disposal techniques employed; and/or such other factors as the Permit Board deems appropriate.

Dennis Riecke moved to grant the siting criteria variance requested by Auburn Apartments LLC and Les Herrington seconded the motion. In addition, a vote by show of hands was five to one to accept the variance request. David Dockery opposed the motion. Therefore, the Permit Board voted to grant the variance.

Gold Coast Commodities Inc., Wastewater Treatment Site

Issuance of State Operating No Discharge Permit

Rankin County - MSU218003

Ms. Krystal Rudolph, Chief of the Environmental Permits Division (EPD), advised the Permit Board that Gold Coast Commodities Inc., Wastewater Treatment Site, applied for a proposed issuance of a State Operating Discharge Permit MSU218003. The facility will be located on Lake Road in Pelahatchie, Rankin County, Mississippi.

Ms. Rudolph stated the proposed draft permit, which contains regulatory limitations and constraints, would allow the facility to treat the wastewater generated at the Gold Coast Commodities, Inc. facility located at 817 North College Street in Brandon, Mississippi, in Rankin County. The Gold Coast Brandon location manufactures various vegetable oils using several processes that generate wastewater. All of the wastewater generated at the site will be transported from the Gold Coast Brandon site via tanker trucks to the Gold Coast Wastewater Treatment site located in Pelahatchie. The proposed treatment site located in Pelahatchie will consist of an aerated lagoon followed by land application with no discharge.

MDEQ conducted a site inspection on June 25, 2018, and determined the proposed site complied with all buffer requirements. Ms. Rudolph stated the Permit Board can consider a facility's compliance history when determining whether to issue a permit. She advised the Board that MDEQ has an open enforcement action pending against Gold Coast Brandon related to the disposal of their wastewater. Specifically, she stated in October 2016, MDEQ staff opened an investigation after receiving complaints from the City of Brandon alleging that Gold Coast was wrongfully disposing its wastewater into the City's sewer. MDEQ conducted an initial investigation and issued a Notice of Violation to Gold Coast Brandon. Additionally, MDEQ investigated an incidence of Gold Coast wastewater being disposed of into the City of Jackson sewer by another company hired by Gold Coast for wastewater disposal. This incident resulted in the issuance of a Commission Order ordering the disposal to cease. The Order contains a provision that Gold Coast cannot dispose of its wastewater inside the State of Mississippi without written approval of MDEQ. MDEQ has also issued a Notice of Violation to Gold Coast for violations of the Commission Order relating to reports that had to be submitted to MDEQ. Lastly, MDEQ issued a third Notice of Violation related to disposal of Gold Coast wastewater into the City of Pelahatchie's Publicly Owned Treatment Works among other things. Ms. Rudolph stated MDEQ's investigation is ongoing and the enforcement matter has not yet been resolved.

Ms. Rudolph also advised the Permit Board that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Criminal Investigation Division is investigating Gold Coast concerning its previous handling of its wastewater in Mississippi. Furthermore, the City of Brandon is currently seeking damages in a civil lawsuit for damage to the City's collection system allegedly resulting from the disposal of Gold Coast wastewater into the City's sewer system. Because of concerns related to Gold Coast's past operations, MDEQ staff did not make a recommendation for issuance of the permit. However, because neither the criminal matter nor the administrative enforcement matters have been finally adjudicated, staff did not feel it could recommend denial.

Mr. Sam Harden is the engineer overseeing the design of the proposed Gold Coast treatment system. He described the system design to the Permit Board and stated he appreciated the Board separating the permit issuance from the issues raised in the enforcement action. Attorney Ritch Glaze also addressed the Board on behalf of his client Gold Coast. He stated that Gold Coast disagrees with MDEQ's statement that there have been significant violations; however, he stated everyone recognizes the proposed permit meets the regulatory requirements. He further advised the Board of his client's efforts to come into compliance. Specifically, he stated that since 2017, Gold Coast has spent about a million and a half dollars sending its wastewater out of state. Mr. Glaze indicated Gold Coast has also spent almost six hundred thousand dollars constructing the lagoon and will spend another couple of hundred thousand dollars to ensure the lagoon works properly. Before the last storm water inspection, Gold Coast hired EarthCon to audit its storm water system and rewrite its SWPPP. Mr. Harden stated if Gold Coast is required to continue shipping its wastewater out of state, it would likely result in Gold Coast going out of business.

General Counsel Roy Furrh stated the Board may consider an applicant's compliance history in deciding whether to issue a permit. Vice Chair Jennifer Wittmann asked about the legal repercussions of tabling consideration of the proposed permit issuance until resolution of the enforcement action. Mr. Furrh stated MDEQ would not typically consider permit issuance before resolution of an enforcement action, but decided to present the matter to the Board at the request of Gold Coast. Mr. Furrh stated issuance of a permit would not affect the enforcement action. Vice Chair Wittmann asked whether MDEQ could conduct more compliance inspections at the Gold Coast site if the Board issued the permit. Mr. Tim Aultman, Chief of MDEQ's Compliance and Enforcement Division, stated MDEQ conducts unannounced inspections and can inspect more often if a facility's compliance history warrants more frequent inspections.

On motion by David Snodgrass and seconded by Jennifer Wittmann, with one opposed vote (Dennis Riecke), and two abstentions (Les Herrington and David Dockery), the Permit Board voted to issue the No Discharge Permit coverage with the contingency that MDEQ conduct more unannounced inspections of the facility. Note Chairman McDonald voted for the Motion.

OTHER BUSINESS

**Renaissance at Colony Park, LLC
Water Quality Certification No. WQC 2015041
Madison County, Mississippi**

MDEQ attorney, Lisa Ouzts, presented proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law ("FOFCOL") for consideration regarding the Permit Board's denial of Petitioner Stephen M. Maloney's request for revocation of Water Quality Certification No. 2015041 which the Permit Board previously issued to Renaissance at Colony Park, LLC ("Renaissance").

Ms. Ouzts stated that MDEQ provided the draft to Petitioner Stephen Maloney and to Renaissance's attorney John Brunini for comment. Ms. Ouzts stated that she incorporated many of the comments she received from Mr. Maloney and Mr. Brunini. She stated she provided the final draft FOFCOL, Mr. Maloney's comments, and Mr. Brunini's comments to the Permit Board for review prior to the Board's meeting. Ms. Ouzts stated that Petitioner Maloney and Mr. Brunini had been informed that the Permit Board would consider the proposed FOFCOL at its meeting. There were no visitors present who wished to speak for or against the proposed FOFCOL. Ms. Ouzts recommended that the Permit Board adopt the draft FOFCOL.

Permit Board Member Dennis Riecke moved to accept staff's recommendation and adopt the FOFCOL. Permit Board Member Chris Hawkins seconded the motion and the Permit Board voted unanimously to adopt the FOFCOL.

Following the Renaissance matter, MDEQ's General Counsel, Roy Furrh, informed the Permit Board that the Hearing Officer had submitted his findings and recommendations in the Le Poultry matter. Mr. Furrh advised the Permit Board members that the findings and recommendations would be delivered to the Permit Board members later today or tomorrow and stated MDEQ staff recommended that the Permit Board hold a special meeting to consider the findings and recommendations. Mr. Furrh stated legal counsel for the concerned citizens and Le Poultry had agreed on two potential dates for a special meeting to consider the matter. Specifically, counsel proposed either Tuesday, August 27, 2019, or Thursday, August 29, 2019, as dates for a special meeting. Mr. Furrh stated he anticipated the hearing officer would present his findings and recommendations to the Permit Board for consideration at the special meeting. Mr. Furrh stated the Permit Board would have a couple of weeks before the special meeting to review the various motions filed by the parties, the responses, the replies, and the Hearing Officers findings and recommendations. Mr. Furrh did not discuss the merits of the matter. Ms. Wittmann indicated she could not make the meeting at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, August 27, because that was run-off election day. The Permit Board discussed holding the special meeting at 10:30 a.m. on August 27, 2019, pending confirmation of Mr. Riecke's availability.

CONFIRMATION OF THE NEXT REGULAR PERMIT BOARD MEETING

Chair Chris McDonald confirmed that the next Regular Meeting will be held on September 10, 2019.

MEETING ADJOURNED

There being no further business to come before the Permit Board, Chair Chris McDonald adjourned the meeting.
