- 1) City Council Meeting overview - 1/31/17
  - a. Concerns from Eastern Heights community
    - i. Understanding their indoor air results
    - ii. Drinking water (rotten egg/Sulphur smell)
    - iii. TCE concentrations present in ambient air above screening level/RML
  - b. Workers health concerns
    - i. Indoor air concentrations (past and current exposures)
    - ii. Worker exposures from consuming drinking water from the production well while working onsite
    - iii. Cancer deaths in the community (former workers and exposures from living within close proximity of the site)
  - c. Concerns from residents of the Airport Circle community
    - i. Drinking water
    - ii. Air quality concerns from nearby industry
    - iii. Request for Ambient air monitoring because of their proximity to Eastern Heights neighborhood
    - iv. Request for sampling of the soil in their neighborhood because of the historical use as
    - v. Army airfield built in about 1942 for pilot training in World War II and subsequently a municipal airport
    - vi. Strong concerns about buried industrial sewer/wastewater lines underneath their property that percolate discolored water on to their property
