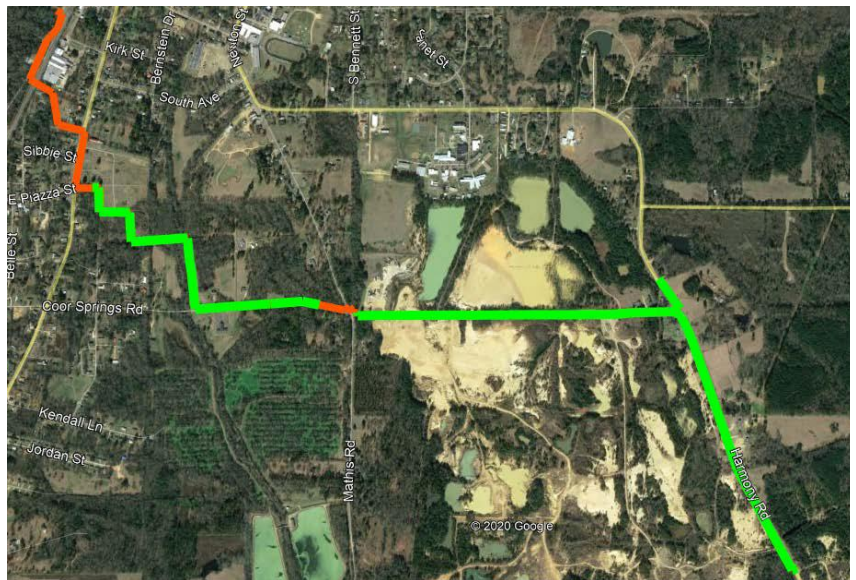
## CURRENT PROGRESS AND UPCOMING PROJECTS

### *Soil Vapor Extraction Progress*

The Soil Vapor Extraction system continues to operate as designed, safely removing chemicals from soils below the building. Sampling indicates that it is also having a positive impact on the groundwater quality beneath the facility. However, as part of our continual improvement efforts, studies are underway to further augment system performance and decrease the amount of time required to remove the chemicals under the building.

### *City Water Supply Pipeline*

The installation of the new City water main from the Harmony Road wells to the City water plant is approximately 50% complete. Surveying and clearing is underway for the next portion. Erosion control measures are being employed behind the installations as construction progresses. Detailed information is being captured as the installation progresses in order to produce drawings and location information for use by the City in the future. Pipe tracer materials are being installed along the entire length of the piping for future detection.



### *City Water Supply*

The existing City wells continue to be sampled monthly and reported to MDEQ and the City. The third and most recent municipal water supply well that was installed is not yet operational as the electrical power service has not been installed by the power company to date. This new well will go through a prescriptive protocol dictated by the Health department before being put into service.
