Mr. D. W. Lamey requested permit P04-006AA (Harrison County) be transferred to Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. has provided the required bonding and transfer forms to MDEQ. If approved, the new permit number for Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. will be P04-006AAT. The staff recommended through Ron Porter approval of the transfer request.

Mr. D. W. Lamey also requested permit P89-022T1 (Harrison County) be transferred to Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. has provided the required bonding and transfer forms to MDEQ. If approved, the new permit number for Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. will be P89-022T2. The staff recommended through Ron Porter approval of the transfer request.

Mr. D. W. Lamey also requested permit P93-051T1 (Harrison County) be transferred to Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. has provided the required bonding and transfer forms to MDEQ. If approved, the new permit number for Lamey Brothers Trucking, Inc. will be P93-051T2. The staff recommended through Ron Porter approval of the transfer request.

On motion by Chris Hawkins and seconded by David Snodgrass, the Permit Board voted to approve the above surface mining permit transfers. (David Dockery abstained)

SOLID WASTE PERMITTING BRANCH**

**Greenway Environmental Services Landfill  
Transfer of SW0320040549**

Mr. Trent Jones, Manager of the Solid Waste Permitting and Certification Branch in MDEQ's Waste Division, presented the proposed transfer of solid waste management permit (No. SW0320040549) from Riverbend Environmental Services, LLC (Riverbend) to Greenway Environmental Services (Greenway) for the Riverbend Environmental Services landfill that is located southwest of Fayette in Jefferson County, Mississippi. The applicant also requested that the name of the landfill be changed to Greenway Environmental Services Landfill.

Riverbend filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy in October 2019. Mr. Jones stated that the Riverbend Landfill had been the subject of a number of MDEQ compliance and enforcement actions over the past few years, culminating most recently in an order to cease and desist operation of the landfill issued to Riverbend on July 7, 2020. Greenway sought to purchase the landfill and, pending the bankruptcy court's approval of the sale, Greenway entered into an Agreed Order with MDEQ on August 27, 2020, in which it agreed to assume operations of the landfill and to correct existing compliance issues at the landfill in accordance with an approved compliance plan and schedule. Greenway and Riverbend entered an agreement in September 2020 whereby Greenway would purchase the landfill and apply for a permit transfer; the court approved the agreement and Greenway assumed the operations of the landfill under the Agreed Order in September 2020. Based on MDEQ's observations of Greenway's recent operations, Mr. Jones stated Greenway is taking the necessary actions to address the commitments it made in its compliance plans and is improving the landfill operations. Should the Permit Board approve the transfer, Greenway must provide financial assurance to ensure adequate resources are available to properly close the facility and conduct the required post-closure monitoring.

Based on MDEQ's review of the application and the supporting documents, MDEQ preliminarily concluded that Greenway met the requirements and conditions for the transfer of the solid waste management permit. MDEQ published a public notice soliciting input on the proposed transfer over a 30-day public comment period from October 7, 2020, through November 6, 2020. MDEQ additionally held an online public hearing on October 29, 2020, to receive public comments on the proposed operations and draft permits. While there were no public comments during the online public hearing, MDEQ received one comment letter from a nearby property owner during the public comment period expressing various concerns including concerns with past compliance problems. MDEQ provided the comment letter to the Permit Board prior to its consideration of the transfer application. No visitors at the Permit Board spoke in opposition to the proposed transfer.

Mr. Jones pointed out that transferring the landfill to a new owner that has demonstrated its commitment to making necessary corrections and long-term improvements is preferable to requiring closure of the landfill, which would likely require the State of Mississippi to assume responsibility for closure. Mr. Jones noted that the Agreed Order and the approved compliance plan requires Greenway to improve the facility operations, promptly construct additional disposal cells, correct waste disposal and leachate management issues, and correct storm water management issues. MDEQ's inspections of the landfill during Greenway's operation have confirmed that Greenway has already made numerous improvements to the site operations and is currently working to construct new disposal cells and upgrade various landfill features.

Mr. Jones advised the Permit Board that the existing solid waste management permit will expire on July 31, 2021; consequently, Greenway must submit a comprehensive permit renewal application in February 2021. Greenway must also submit applications to renew the existing air and water permits for the facility within the next few months. Thus, MDEQ will have another opportunity to evaluate conditions at the landfill as part of its review of the renewal applications. If the renewal applications are determined complete, MDEQ will develop draft permit recommendations and will request additional public comment and input prior to bringing the renewals to the Permit Board. Thus, there will be additional opportunities to evaluate Greenway's operation of the landfill.

The staff recommended transfer of Solid Waste Management Permit No. SW0320040549 to Greenway Environmental Services, LLC for the operation of the Greenway Environmental Services Landfill through July 31, 2021.

On motion by Les Herrington and seconded by David Snodgrass, the Permit Board voted to accept the staff's recommendation and transfer the permit to Greenway Environmental Services, LLC for the operation of the Greenway Environmental Services Landfill through July 31, 2021.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITS DIVISION**

**Gold Coast Commodities, Inc.  
State Operating No Discharge Permit No. MSU218003  
Rankin County, Mississippi**

Permit Board Chair Jennifer Wittmann requested that the discussion and consideration of a State Operating No Discharge Permit (No. MSU218003), issued to Gold Coast Commodities, Inc. (Gold Coast) for a wastewater treatment facility in Pelahatchie, Mississippi, be placed on the Board's agenda for the November meeting. The Permit Board issued the permit to Gold Coast in August 2019. Attorney Andy Taggart filed a Motion to Continue Consideration of the Permit on behalf of Gold Coast urging the Permit Board to delay its consideration of the permit until after November 19, 2020, when the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) would hold an evidentiary hearing to consider two Commission Orders involving the Gold Coast facility. Mr. Taggart also stated in the motion that he had a hearing before the Mississippi Supreme Court the afternoon of November 10, 2020, which would prevent him from attending the Permit Board meeting. The Motion to Continue was provided to the Permit Board for review in advance of the meeting. Rich Glaze, one of Gold Coast's attorneys, was present at the Permit Board meeting and he requested that the matter be continued because Mr. Taggart represents Gold Coast in the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality matter. Thus, for consistency, Mr. Glaze requested the motion be granted. Mr. Glaze acknowledged that Gold Coast anticipated the Board may deny the motion and that he was prepared to address the Permit Board if the Board should so deny. On motion by Les Herrington and seconded by Dennis Riecke, the Permit Board unanimously voted to deny Gold Coast's Motion to Continue.

Upon request from the Permit Board, MDEQ Senior Attorney Gretchen Zmitrovich summarized the two Commission Orders that MDEQ's Executive Director, Chris Wells, issued on behalf of the Commission related to violations of Gold Coast's wastewater treatment facility in Pelahatchie, Mississippi. Director Wells issued the first Order, No. 7069 20, on September 11, 2020, after receiving multiple odor complaints and citing other violations that are outlined in the Order. The Order required Gold Coast to stop sending wastewater into the lagoon because the lagoon was almost full, to stop irrigating because it had not reached the appropriate constituent levels required in the permit to allow for irrigation, to submit a plan for MDEQ approval to profile the wastewater in the lagoon, to submit a vector control plan, to submit an odor control plan, to install a depth marker as required by the permit, and to maintain sufficient freeboard at all times. The Order further noted that Gold Coast was still subject to a previous Order forbidding it from sending its wastewater to any facility in Mississippi without MDEQ's written approval. Ms. Zmitrovich stated that after MDEQ continued to receive odor complaints and inadequate responses from Gold Coast, Director Wells issued a second Order, No. 7074 20, on October 1, 2020, requiring Gold Coast to develop a plan to pump out all of the wastewater from the lagoon within 60 days and bringing forward the requirement from the previous Orders prohibiting Gold Coast from sending its wastewater to any Mississippi facility without first obtaining MDEQ's written approval.

Gold Coast's consultant, Sam Hardin with Clearwater Consultants, replied that the first Order was issued on a Friday and he responded, on Gold Coast's behalf, on the following Thursday. After being told the information was incomplete, Mr. Hardin stated Gold Coast submitted additional information to MDEQ on the following day. He stated that on the day the vector control plan was due pursuant to the Order, he informed MDEQ that Gold Coast had hired a third party contractor to conduct a comprehensive review and develop and implement a vector control plan which would be provided to MDEQ in one week. The second Order was issued before the information was delivered to MDEQ. He stated there has been no delay in addressing the odors, vectors (flies), and the wastewater in the lagoon as required by the Orders. He stated there has been a steady decline in organic strength in the wastewater which has resulted in a steady decline in odor. He also stated that flies are currently all but non-existent and that the vector control plan continues to be implemented. He acknowledged there had been some equipment malfunctions that caused some of the odor and other issues. Mr. Hardin stated a third party consultant with expertise in microbial testing and biological assays determined, after conducting a study, that a lagoon was a viable treatment option for Gold Coast's wastewater. He

stated that while the lagoon design contemplates four aerators, the lagoon currently has five aerators. Mr. Hardin stated his opinion that aeration is the most long-term and permanent solution to control odors at the lagoon.

Rich Glaze, attorney for Gold Coast, acknowledged the issues with the lagoon that resulted in the issuance of the two Commission Orders. He stated that Gold Coast consultants Harry Wilson, a former MDEQ employee who is now with FC&E consulting, and Todd French, PhD, with Mississippi State University, did not find the odors objectionable on the dates they visited the site and surrounding areas. He described a release of hydrogen sulfide gas at the lagoon. He explained that Gold Coast had begun discharging its wastewater into the lagoon in anticipation of the aerators being delivered; however, he stated that delivery of the aerators was delayed for several months due to COVID-19. When the aerators were installed and began operating, hydrogen sulfide gas was released and several people, including the father of one of Gold Coast's owners, were overcome by the fumes and required medical care due to their exposure to the gas. Mr. Glaze stated that none of Gold Coast's consultants anticipated the gas release. Mr. Glaze also addressed a release of wastewater to Dry Creek which occurred when an electrician who was working on an electrical panel at the lagoon site accidentally turned on the switch to the irrigation system. He stated this occurred on a Friday but Gold Coast did not know about the release until the following Saturday evening. He stated Gold Coast immediately began to remediate damages caused by the release and noted an adjoining landowner, Mr. Buck Alman, testified favorably to Gold Coast's efforts to address issues with the lagoon. Mr. Glaze stated Gold Coast's consultants provided sworn testimony in the Commission matter that the lagoon could be effectively operated with the fifth aerator, and the odors at the lagoon were not bad when they visited the lagoon. Mr. Glaze stated Gold Coast did not expect before the deadlines specified in the first Order, that there would be a second Order requiring Gold Coast to be told they could no longer use the lagoon and that they would be ordered to evacuate the lagoon. He stated Gold Coast complied with the first Order and the prospects for the lagoon to function properly are good.

In response to a question by Permit Board Chair Wittmann, Mr. Glaze acknowledged that Gold Coast had disposed of its wastewater into the lagoon for eight months before the aerators were installed but stated the lagoon had to contain water before the aerators were installed. Ms. Wittmann asked when Gold Coast knew that the aerators would be delayed and whether Gold Coast continued to dispose of its wastewater into the lagoon knowing about the delay. Ms. Wittmann pointed out that at the August 2019 meeting, when the Permit Board was considering permit issuance, the Board had questions regarding Gold Coast's prior compliance history. She further noted that MDEQ staff did not make a recommendation regarding permit issuance. In light of these concerns, Ms. Wittmann asked whether Gold Coast notified MDEQ that delivery of the aerators had been delayed. Mr. Glaze stated Gold Coast became aware the aerators were delayed when they were not delivered on time and they kept getting promises that the aerators were on the way. He admitted that Gold Coast continued to dispose of its wastewater in the lagoon; however, he stated Gold Coast had no choice and that its consultants stated the continued discharge would not affect the lagoon. He also stated it was not a violation of the permit to dispose of wastewater into the lagoon before the aerators were installed. MDEQ visited the site in June 2020 and discovered the lagoon was almost full. Danny Beasley, with MDEQ's Compliance and Enforcement Division, stated Gold Coast first began discharging wastewater into the lagoon in November 2019 and that there was sufficient water in the lagoon by December 2019—before COVID was an issue—and that aerators could have, and should have, been in place. Ultimately, the aerators were not in place until July 2020.

The Permit Board heard conflicting comments regarding the odors and vectors at the site. Mr. Glaze stated that Mr. Alman, a neighboring landowner, testified that odors were not nuisance level. Mr. Beasley, pointing out that Mr. Alman's residence is roughly one mile away, disagreed with Mr. Alman's statement regarding odors. He acknowledged that the flies, while still present as of the Friday before the Permit Board's meeting, were not as bad. Ms. Lane Stubbs addressed the Permit Board regarding odors. Her father is the nearest homeowner to the lagoon. She stated the odors were bad the day before the meeting and were not improving and that she was worried about the long-term effects on her father.

Ms. Wittmann read Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-28 (1) which confers upon the Permit Board the authority to issue, reissue, modify, or revoke permits. In response to Permit Board questions regarding revocation, MDEQ's General Counsel, Roy Furrh, stated the applicable

regulations provided the Permit Board the authority to revoke permits for cause and that it was up to the Board to determine whether there is cause for revocation. He stated if the Board revoked the permit, Gold Coast could request an evidentiary hearing and, if so, pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-29 (3)(c), the permit would remain in effect until the resolution of the evidentiary hearing. The Permit Board asked Mr. Furrh about the Commission hearing scheduled for November 19, and he stated the Commission is a separate body that handles enforcement matters and would consider the Orders, and possible penalties, and the Permit Board makes decisions regarding permits.

On motion by David Snodgrass, and seconded by Les Herrington, the Permit Board unanimously voted to revoke Gold Coast's permit.

## **EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

### **IN THE MATTER OF: EVIDENTIARY HEARING REQUEST REGARDING THE FINAL RELEASE OF THE REMAINING 80 PERCENT OF RECLAMATION BOND COVERING SURFACE MINING PERMIT NO. P99-071A ISSUED TO ALL SOUTH CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, NESHOPA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

The matter before the Permit Board was the final 80 percent surface mining reclamation bond release for All South Construction Company ("All South"), (Permit No. P99-071A). This was an 11-acre open pit mine for sand and clay, which is located in Neshoba County, approximately 5 miles south of Philadelphia.

The Permit Board approved the final bond release at its regular meeting on May 12, 2020. Mr. Corris Banks Matthews, Ms. Mary Adkins, and Ms. Martha Cumberland ("Petitioners") each submitted a written request for a formal evidentiary hearing, objecting to the Permit Board's final 80 percent release of the reclamation bond for the All South surface mining permit.

The hearing officer in this matter was Leyser Hayes. General Counsel Roy Furrh and Senior Attorney Ted Lampton represented the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). Petitioners Corris Banks Matthews, Mary Adkins, and Martha Cumberland all represented themselves pro se. All South ("Intervenor") was represented by Gaston Barrett, pro se, and Walton Stinson, pro se. MDEQ submitted prefiled direct testimony through the affidavits of James L. Matheny and Ronald A. Porter and submitted prefiled rebuttal testimony through the affidavit of James L. Matheny. All South submitted prefiled direct and rebuttal testimony through the affidavits of Gaston Barrett. Petitioner Mary Adkins submitted prefiled direct testimony, and Petitioner Martha Cumberland also submitted prefiled direct testimony. Petitioner Corris Banks Matthews submitted prefiled direct and rebuttal testimony.

As a preliminary matter, Hearing Officer Hayes entered the Orders that were issued pursuant to the pre-hearing conference into the record, including the Order granting MDEQ's Motion in Limine and Motion to Strike Documents, as well as the Order granting All South's Motion to Intervene. The following testimony was redacted (in part) pursuant to the Hearing Officer's granting of MDEQ's Motion in Limine and Motion to Strike Documents: The prefiled direct and rebuttal testimony of Corris Banks Matthews, the prefiled direct testimony of Mary Adkins, the prefiled direct testimony of Martha Cumberland, the prefiled direct testimony of Ronald A. Porter, and the prefiled rebuttal testimony of James L. Matheny. The redacted versions were entered into the record as indicated below.

Ted Lampton made an opening statement on behalf of MDEQ, followed by Mr. Stinson who made an opening statement on behalf of All South. Mr. Matthews then made an opening statement, as did Ms. Adkins and then Ms. Cumberland.

Ronald A. Porter testified for MDEQ through his prefiled direct testimony, which was introduced as evidence into the record. MDEQ then tendered Mr. Porter for cross-examination. Mr. Porter was cross-examined by Mr. Matthews, then was redirected by Mr. Furrh, and was questioned by the Permit Board. James L. Matheny testified for MDEQ through his prefiled direct and rebuttal testimony, which were introduced as evidence into the record. MDEQ tendered Mr. Matheny for cross-examination. Mr. Matheny was cross-examined by Mr. Matthews, then was redirected by Mr. Furrh, and was questioned by the Permit Board.

Walton Stinson testified on behalf of All South. Mr. Stinson was cross-examined by Corris Matthews.

Gaston Barrett testified on behalf of All South through his prefiled direct and rebuttal testimony, which were introduced as evidence into the record. All South tendered Mr. Barrett for cross-examination. Mr. Barrett was cross-examined by Mr. Matthews and questioned by the Permit Board.

Mr. Matthews testified through his prefiled direct and rebuttal testimony, which were introduced as evidence into the record. Mr. Matthews further testified, then made himself available for cross-examination. Mr. Matthews was cross-examined by Mr. Stinson and questioned by the Permit Board.

Ms. Adkins testified through her prefiled direct testimony, which was introduced as evidence into the record. Ms. Adkins then made herself available for cross-examination.

Ms. Cumberland testified through her prefiled direct testimony, which was introduced as evidence into the record. Ms. Cumberland then made herself available for cross-examination.

At the conclusion of all testimony, Mr. Lampton made a closing statement on behalf of MDEQ, followed by Mr. Stinson who made a closing statement on behalf of All South. Mr. Matthews then made a closing statement. Ms. Adkins and Ms. Cumberland both declined to make a closing statement. The matter was then presented to the Permit Board for its decision.

Upon motion by Mr. David Snodgrass and seconded by Mr. Dennis Riecke, the Permit Board unanimously voted to affirm its prior decision to release the final 80 percent of the reclamation bond covering Surface Mining Permit No. P99-071A issued to All South Construction Company, Neshoba County, Mississippi. Mr. Dockery abstained from the vote.

Hearing Officer Hayes explained the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law process established by the Rules of Practice and Procedure for Formal Evidentiary Hearings before the Permit Board (11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 1 Ch. 6), then closed the record and the hearing was concluded.

**OTHER BUSINESS**

MDEQ's General Counsel, Roy Furrh, informed the Permit Board that it is yet to be determined if the December 8, 2020, Permit Board meeting will be held telephonically, in person, or by zoom. Mr. Furrh informed the Permit Board that he would make them aware in advance so they could plan accordingly.

**CONFIRMATION OF THE NEXT REGULAR PERMIT BOARD MEETING**

Chair Jennifer Wittmann confirmed that the next Regular Meeting will be held on December 8, 2020.

**MEETING ADJOURNED**

There being no further business to come before the Permit Board, Chair Jennifer Wittmann adjourned the meeting.
