Introduction

Residents near the Rockwell International Wheel & Trim Superfund Site are invited to attend and participate in a Community Advisory Group (CAG) Training Session. The purpose of this session is to provide framework and guidance to assist the community in forming this group. The **Technical Advisor** assigned to Eastern Heights will be introduced at this session. Participants who attend this training will be a part of the CAG which plans to meet, at a minimum, quarterly.

Purpose of Community Advisory Group

- A CAG is designed to serve as the focal point for the exchange of information among the local community and the EPA, the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality, and other pertinent Federal agencies involved in cleanup of the Superfund site.
- It will provide a public forum for community members to present and discuss their needs and concerns related to the Superfund decision-making process. A CAG can assist the EPA in making better decisions on the site cleanup.
- It offers the EPA a unique opportunity to hear and seriously consider community preferences for site cleanup and remediation.
- CAGs can also facilitate the exchange of information, including the perspectives of community members with important institutional knowledge of site issues and practices, and decisions made throughout the Superfund process.
