

**MINUTES OF THE MISSISSIPPI ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PERMIT BOARD
HELD IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2021**

The Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board held a meeting in the Commission Hearing Room of the Department of Environmental Quality, located at 515 East Amite Street, on February 9, 2021. Covid-19 protocols were implemented at the in-person meeting related to mandatory social distancing and face mask requirements. Limited seating was available at the meeting in order to comply with social distancing requirements. Mr. James Matheny, Director of the Surface Mining and Reclamation Division of MDEQ's Office of Geology, presented Standard Construction Company, Inc., Three Sisters Mine, surface mining permit application (No A2043) to the Permit Board. The operator, Standard Construction, Inc., proposed to open pit mine 75 acres to a total depth of 55 feet for sand and gravel. The plant site, haul roads, impoundments, and stockpiles will cover 44 acres. There will be 27 acres of buffer zone surrounding the site. Reclamation will consist of three-to-one grassed slopes. A \$1,000 per acre reclamation bond is required from Standard Construction.

Mr. Matheny stated that during the application and public notice processes, staff received several letters and phone calls from area residents who were concerned about the proposed surface mine. Staff also received several formal requests for a public hearing.

Standard Construction Company submitted a Mining Notice of Intent (MNOI) and an associated Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) on to the Office of Pollution Control on April 13, 2020. This submittal was to seek coverage under Mississippi's Mining Storm Water, Dewatering, and No Discharge General Permit for the proposed mine in Desoto County.

On October 8, 2020, MDEQ's Office of Geology conducted a virtual public hearing to hear comments regarding the proposed mining operation. MDEQ's Office of Pollution Control staff also participated in this public hearing to listen to concerns from the interested public. Following the hearing, MDEQ staff drafted a "response to comments" document. MDEQ's staff distributed the response to comments document to the Permit Board and to those who commented during the public hearing. The Permit Board had also been previously provided with copies of the public hearing transcript, written public comments, the surface mining permit application, the draft surface mining permit, the storm water MNOI, the SWPPP, and Standard's fugitive dust control plan, and the Desoto County Board of Supervisors' Conditional Use Order.

Coverage under the Mining Stormwater permit from the Office of Pollution Control requires the operator to install and maintain controls to minimize or prevent sediment loss from the site. The storm water permit coverage will remain in effect throughout the mining and reclamation phases of the site. MDEQ reviewed the required MNOI and SWPPP and deemed them complete and stated the SWPPP adequately addressed storm water discharges from the project site. Further, the stormwater permit requires the operator to install proper sediment controls and use best management practices. Some of the storm water controls Standard Construction will implement during the mining phase include, but are not limited to, silt fences, berms, and brush barriers.

The Desoto County Board of Supervisors initially voted against granting Standard Construction a conditional use permit to mine the site; following reversal of this decision by the Mississippi Supreme Court, the Desoto County Board of Supervisors issued a Conditional Use Order to Standard Construction which included local conditions for the operation of the proposed surface mining site.

Mr. John Burrell, with the homeowners' association of neighbors surrounding the area, communicated his concerns regarding the DeSoto County Board of Supervisors' initial denial of the conditional use order for the proposed mine. Mr. Matheny stated the Mississippi Supreme Court reversed that decision and that the Board of Supervisors subsequently issued a conditional use order to Standard Construction allowing it to operate the mine. Ms. Rita Harris, who lives 50 feet from the property line where the gravel pit will be located, voiced her concerns about compliance issues and her fear that the mine would destroy her property. Mr. Ronnie Hall expressed concerns about health, noise, and safety and was particularly concerned about the potential for mining accidents. Mr. Matheny stated that mine safety is regulated by Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) and not the Permit Board. Mr. Matheny stated the permit application meets MDEQ requirements and that, to his knowledge, there were no impediments to permit issuance.

Before conclusion of the matter Mr. Roy Furrh, General Counsel of MDEQ, read a list of conditions the DeSoto County Board of Supervisor included in the Conditional Use Order issued to Standard Construction and offered to send a copy to Ms. Rita Harris via email. Mr. Furrh also stated that interested parties aggrieved by the Permit Board's decision could request an evidentiary hearing on the proposed surface mining permit and stormwater permit coverage, if issued, within 30 days of the meeting.

Upon motion by Dennis Riecke and seconded by Les Herrington, the Permit voted to approve the issuance of coverage of the general stormwater permit (MSR322863) and the surface mining permit A2043 presented by James Matheny. (David Dockery abstained)

Reissuance of Air Title V Operating Permit No. 1280-00008

Carla Brown, Air Program Manager of the Environmental Permits Division (EPD), advised the Permit Board that VT Halter Marine is seeking reissuance of its Title V Permit, Number 1280-00008, to operate air emissions equipment for its Pascagoula operation located at 900 Bayou Cassotte Parkway in Pascagoula, Mississippi. Ms. Brown advised the Permit Board that operations at the facility generally consist of surface coating, welding, abrasive blasting, and fuel storage related to shipbuilding and ship repair and that emissions of volatile organic compounds and hazardous air pollutants result mostly from surface coating operations, emissions of particulate matter result from abrasive blasting operations and, to a lesser extent, surface coating and welding.

The proposed Title V permit addresses modifications and operational changes at the facility, which were required by a 2014 Agreed Order, that resolved issues largely related to fugitive dust. Specifically, the permit addresses use and maintenance of air pollution controls related to a new blasting and painting building, where the majority of blasting and painting related to shipbuilding takes place. The permit also incorporates a Site-Specific Dust Control Plan, making certain best management practices enforceable as a practical matter. The proposed permit continues to limit emissions of volatile organic compounds to below the Prevention of Significant Deterioration, or PSD, threshold and addresses hazardous air pollutants regulated by EPA's National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants from Shipbuilding and Ship Repair surface coating operations.

Aware of public interest regarding this permit action and in coordination with the Office of Community Engagement, the Department issued a 47-day public notice beginning on July 8, 2020. An informal public meeting, held on July 21, 2020, using the Zoom meeting application, was followed by a formal public hearing on August 13, 2020, also using Zoom. The comment period ended on August 24, 2020. Information related to the meetings, as well as the permit and relevant documents, were made available for the public to access on a dedicated website.

MDEQ staff thoroughly evaluated all comments submitted during the comment period. MDEQ staff prepared a "Response to Comments" document and proposed minor changes to the draft permit to address some of the comments. For Title V permits, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has a 45-day comment period to review the proposed Title V permit. Due to public interest in the industry in this area, EPA conducted its 45-day review after MDEQ's public notice period concluded. On October 26, 2020, MDEQ submitted the proposed Title V permit, the public comments, and MDEQ's "Response to Comments" document to EPA which started EPA's 45-day review period. MDEQ sent a copy of the "Response to Comments document" to the commenters and informed them that the 45-day EPA review had begun. EPA's Region 4 staff also reviewed the comments, MDEQ's responses, and the proposed Title V Operating Permit and had no further comments. The Permit Board received a copy of MDEQ's Response to Comments document, which had both the written comments received and the public hearing transcript attached and copies of the proposed Title V Operating Permit and related information.

MDEQ notified individuals who submitted oral or written comments during the public hearing and notice period of the February 9, 2021, Permit Board meeting. Some of these individuals attended the meeting either in person or telephonically.

Ms. Jennifer Crosslin, with Cherokee Concerned Citizens of Cherokee Subdivision, stated that dust and fugitive emissions from VT Halter Marine were ongoing issues and that there was a Consent Decree in place addressing the issues. She stated thirty signatures regarding fugitive emissions, dust, and particulate matter on the residents' properties had been gathered from neighbors. Ms. Crosslin stated that in 2013 MDEQ tested and found "black beauty" and that most complaints were being reported to MDEQ's Biloxi office, but nothing had been permanently resolved. Ms. Crosslin stated that VT Halter Marine continues to violate its permit and that the Permit Board should require VT Marine to continuously monitor its air emissions should the Board reissue the permit.

Ms. Barbara Weckesser also voiced her concerns regarding the sandblasting that takes place on the VT Halter Marine site. She believes particles that reach their neighborhood from the site are making the residents sick and some residents are dying from the environmental pollution. She noted a study of environmental scientists that they hired showed significant heavy metals in the air.

Melissa Fortenberry, Chief of MDEQ's Air Division, stated that MDEQ collected five samples in 2016 and 2017 of 58 urban air toxic pollutants. In 2020, Chevron also collected a sample in the neighborhood and analyzed for these pollutants. Ms. Fortenberry noted that none of the pollutants were above one one-hundredth of OSHA's Threshold Limit Value commonly used to determine levels protective of human health. Ms. Fortenberry confirmed that particulate matter was not a part of the monitoring since it is not a designated urban air toxic.

Mrs. Brown stated that MDEQ does visit the facility for Title V inspections at least once every two years, and these visits are typically unannounced. However, during the COVID-19 pandemic, MDEQ has announced its inspections because of COVID protocols.

Ms. Krystal Rudolph, Chief of EPD, stated that MDEQ requires direct monitoring of some facilities using stack testing or continuous emissions monitors, and that there are monitors available for emergency ambient air monitoring. However, Chevron is the only facility in Mississippi required to monitor at the fence line pursuant to federal EPA standard. Ms. Rudolph noted that VT Halter's emissions do not go out a stack, so stack testing and continuous emissions monitoring are not feasible.

Permit Board member David Snodgrass moved to accept the staff's recommendation to reissue the Air Title V Operating Permit No. 1280-00008 and Les Herrington seconded the motion. The Permit Board voted in favor of the motion. (Dennis Riecke abstained)

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Ted Lampton, Senior Attorney with MDEQ's legal division, presented the proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law related to an evidentiary hearing, held on November 10, 2020, on the All South Construction Company bond release matter. At the conclusion of that hearing, the Permit Board affirmed its prior decision to release the final 80 percent bond reclamation release for Surface Mining Permit No. 99-071A issued to All South Construction Company, Neshoba County, Mississippi.

Petitioner, Mr. Corris Mathews, commented regarding his disapproval of the Permit Board's bond release decision. Mr. Roy Furrh, MDEQ's General Counsel, informed Mr. Mathews that his comments had already been considered during the hearing and that the Permit Board's final Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law would be sent to him immediately via email.

Upon motion by Dennis Riecke and seconded by Chris McDonald, the Permit Board voted to approve the proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law (FOFCOL) to memorialize its decision to issue the final 80 percent bond reclamation release for Surface Mining Permit No. 99-071A. (David Dockery abstained)

EVIDENTIARY HEARING

IN THE MATTER OF: EVIDENTIARY HEARING REGARDING THE PERMIT BOARD'S ISSUANCE OF A SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION (No. WQC 2018036) TO THE MISSISSIPPI STATE PORT AUTHORITY (MSPA), GULFPORT, HARRISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

The matter before the Permit Board was a formal evidentiary hearing regarding the Permit Board's issuance of a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (No. WQC 2018036) to the Mississippi State Port Authority (MSPA) for a storage lot for equipment and cargo to support US Department of Defense shipments at its North Port Property located in Gulfport, Harrison County, Mississippi. Petitioners John Johnson, Glenn Cobb, Lattie Grubbs, The Anointed Temple AOH Church, and North Gulfport Land Trust (Petitioners) requested the hearing so the Permit Board could reconsider its action on August 13, 2019, to issue the certification to MSPA.

J. Stevenson Ray, Esq. served as the Hearing Officer. The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) was represented by its General Counsel Roy Furrh and Senior Attorney Lisa Ouzts. MSPA was represented by Attorneys Brant Pettis, Susan Scaggs, and Bradley Ennis of the Balch & Bingham law firm. Petitioners were represented by Attorneys Desiree Hensley and Jordan Hughes with the University of Mississippi's Low Income Housing Clinic. MDEQ pre-filed direct testimony through the affidavit of Florance Bass and pre-filed rebuttal testimony through the affidavit of Florance Bass and Thomas Wallace. MSPA pre-filed direct testimony through the affidavits of Johnathan Daniels, John Webb, Paul Bradley, and Christina Shurley, and pre-filed rebuttal testimony through the affidavits of John Webb, Paul Bradley, Christina Shurley, and John Szabo. Petitioners pre-filed direct testimony through the affidavits of Steven H. Emerman, Earthea Nance, and David Padgett, and pre-filed rebuttal testimony through the affidavits of Steven H. Emerman and Earthea Nance. All witnesses were either physically present, or remotely present via Zoom, and available for cross-examination, questioning by the Permit Board, and redirect.

Mr. Furrh, Mr. Pettis, and Ms. Hensley each made opening statements on behalf of their respective clients. Ms. Bass and Mr. Wallace testified on MDEQ's behalf through their pre-filed testimony affidavits and were tendered for cross-examination, questioning by the Permit Board, and redirect. Mr. Daniels testified through his pre-filed testimony affidavit and was tendered for cross-examination, questioning by the Permit Board, and redirect. Mr. Daniels testified via Zoom to avoid travelling out-of-state during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Permit Board recessed with instructions to counsel to schedule a date and time to reconvene and resume the hearing. When the hearing resumes, the Permit Board will hear testimony from the remaining seven witnesses and closing arguments of the parties' legal counsel.

CONFIRMATION OF THE NEXT REGULAR PERMIT BOARD MEETING

Chair Jennifer Wittmann confirmed that the next Regular Meeting will be held on March 9, 2021.
