

## 2012 - 2020 RESTORE Act Projects Seafood Committee

### Eligible Activities:

- Restoration and protection of the natural resources, ecosystems, fisheries, marine and wildlife habitats, beaches, and coastal wetlands of the Gulf Coast Region.
- Mitigation of damage to fish, wildlife, and natural resources.
- Implementation of a Federally approved marine, coastal, or comprehensive conservation management plan, including fisheries monitoring.
- Infrastructure projects benefitting the ecological resources.
- Promotion of the consumption of seafood harvested from the Gulf Coast Region.
- Workforce development and job creation related to the seafood harvested from the Gulf Coast Region.
- Planning Assistance for one of the eligible activities above.
