Governor's Gulf Coast Advisory Committee's Seafood Subcommittee Meeting September 8, 2021, Official Minutes

I. Meeting Attendees

II. Subcommittee Meeting Discussion

- Executive Director Wells, MDEQ, welcomed the Subcommittee members and attendees to the meeting.
