The Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality is noticing an extension in our public comment period and a change to the public hearing time and date related to the revisions to Title 11 Miss. Admin. Code, Part 3, Chapter 1, Mississippi Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (regulations) as authorized by Section 17-17-27, Mississippi Code of 1972. The original notice on the change to these regulations was public noticed on December 30, 2021 and was set to end with a public hearing to be held on February 10, 2022. The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality is extending the public comment period through March 10, 2022 and will hold the online public hearing at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 10, 2022 to receive comments on the revisions to the regulations. The proposed revisions to the regulations are unchanged from those described in the December 30, 2021 public notice and this notice only serves to extend the public comment period and reschedule the public hearing date.

All written comments regarding the proposed regulatory revisions must be submitted to MDEQ by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 10, 2022 to be considered.

In addition, interested persons may present verbal comments in an online public hearing hosted by MDEQ. The online, public hearing regarding the proposed regulations will be held at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 10, 2022, to provide additional opportunity for the public to comment. This public hearing is being held online out of an abundance of caution related to the COVID-19 pandemic. To participate in the online hearing, interested persons will need to visit the MDEQ website at [www.mdeq.ms.gov/hw\\_regulations](http://www.mdeq.ms.gov/hw_regulations) and register by 11:30 a.m. on March 10. Additional instructions for registration and participation are posted on this webpage. All comments presented during the public hearing will be transcribed and will be reviewed and considered in the same manner as written comments.
