3. FY2025 Title V Fee Recommendation – Approval to Finalize Fee Recommendation

The Air Division is requesting approval to finalize a FY 2025 Title V fee recommendation after completing an associated public notice period and public hearing.

4. MDEQ Air Regulations (Chapters 2 and 5) – Approval to Finalize Revisions

The Air Division is requesting approval to finalize proposed revisions to the MDEQ air regulations, specifically Chapter 2 and Chapter 5, after completing an associated public notice period and public hearing. The proposed revisions are to address various Federal rules that impact MDEQ's air regulations pertaining to permits associated with the construction and/or operation of air emissions equipment.

5. Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality v. City of Jackson Evidentiary Hearing

MDEQ has cited the City of Jackson with the following four groups of violations: 1) failure to provide curbside collection of residential garbage from April 1 through April 18, 2023, which are violations of Miss. Code Ann. § 17-17-5, which requires that municipal governing bodies provide for the collection and disposal of residential garbage; 2) placement of waste in a location likely to cause pollution of waters of the state which are violations of Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-29(2)(a); 3) placement of waste or other products or substances in a location where they are likely to cause pollution of the air which are violations of Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-29(1)(a); and 4) failure to implement the City's approved solid waste management plan which is a violation of Miss. Code Ann. § 17-17-227. The Commission has been provided pre-filed testimony submitted by the parties pursuant to an Agreed Scheduling Order. Ellen O'Neal was designated as the Hearing Officer by the Commission in this matter at its meeting on December 13, 2023. Hearing Officer O'Neal will assist the Commission during the evidentiary hearing and will make rulings on evidentiary matters pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-33. The Commission will consider the assessment of penalties associated with the violations.

6. Asbestos Certifications

Staff has issued 96 asbestos certifications since the last report. This list will be available at the Commission meeting.

7. Lead Paint Certifications

Staff has issued 60 lead paint certifications since the last report. This list will be available at the Commission meeting.

8. Underground Storage Tanks (UST) Certifications

Staff has issued 2 new and 7 renewed certifications to those who install, alter, or remove underground storage tanks since the last report. This list will be available at the Commission meeting.

1	Conditional Approval of the Lauderdale County Solid Waste Management Plan	Order No. 7303 24	This order conditionally approves a comprehensively updated version of the Lauderdale County Solid Waste Management Plan as proposed by the Lauderdale County Board of Supervisors and the municipalities of Meridian and Marion. The updated version of the plan describes the provisions and services for managing solid wastes in the County for the 20 year planning period as required by State Law. The Order additionally provides the County 120 days to address certain deficiencies pertaining to the proposed inclusion of 4 new/expanding solid waste management facilities.
2	Hinds County	Order No. 7304 24 Respondent agreed to submit an interim Storm Water Management Program (SWMP) to MDEQ and comply with this SWMP and the General Permit issued on March 18, 2016 until MDEQ issues a new General Permit.	Respondent was in violation of Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-29(2)(b) for failing to obtain coverage under the Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Storm Water General NPDES Permit that was issued on March 18, 2016.
