



BROWNFIELD REVOLVING LOAN FUND

EPA has awarded MDEQ a Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund (BRLF) Grant to provide funding for capitalizing a BRLF program.

BRLF programs provide loans and subgrants to eligible entities to carry out cleanup activities at brownfield sites contaminated with hazardous substances and/or petroleum.

A loan or subgrant cannot be issued to a party potentially liable for the contamination at a brownfield site under CERCLA §107.

The brownfield site in which a BRLF loan or subgrant is proposed must be a part of a state program (e.g., MS Brownfield Program).

The Mississippi Brownfield Program under the Groundwater Assessment Remediation Division is proposing new regulations, Subchapter 3, under MS Code Title 11, Part 3, Chapter 2 (Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality Final Regulations Governing Brownfield Voluntary Cleanup and Redevelopment in Mississippi (Adopted May 27, 1999, Last Amended February 28, 2002)). The purpose of the new regulations is to establish the MS BRLF program and require any BRLF site to have a MCEQ approved Brownfield Agreement.
