

enHance Program Guide



The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality's Envision Heightened Awareness Nurturing Conservation & Environmental Excellence (enHance) program is a voluntary initiative to recognize an organization's leadership and contribution to the enhancement of the state's environment, natural resources and community well-being. Existing enHance members and new members accepted into the program are committed environmental leaders implementing measures that reduce waste, conserve resources and provide continuous environmental enhancement.

Eligible entities include regulated and non-regulated businesses, industries, governmental agencies, municipalities, schools, associations, community groups, and other similar organizations.

Membership Tiers

As regulated applicants enter the program, they will have access to three levels of membership:

Associate Level

- The entry tier of membership. Facility makes their initial commitment to improving
- environmental performance, develop their implementation plan and completes their first environmental improvement project.

Steward Level

- The intermediate tier of membership.
- Facility has made progress in their stewardship efforts and has completed their second environmental improvement project.

Leader Level

The highest of the program's membership tiers.

- Facility has demonstrated a superior record of environmental compliance and improvement.
- Stewards can become leaders by implementing a community service project or serving as a mentor for other facilities in the program.
- Facility has agreed to follow stricter compliance guidelines by utilizing an Environmental Management System and operating under the ISO 14001 certification (ISO Cert.). An ISO Cert. enhances the facility's green credentials and is designed to ultimately reduce the number of safety incidents which improves production costs and boosts the company image.

Environmental Star

 This tier is open to non-regulated businesses, schools, associations, community groups, and other similar organizations. Non-regulated refers to entities that do not hold environmental permits issued by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality Permit Board or the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

Applications are accepted annually from July 1st to November 30th, or later. enHance applicants must download the membership application form, fill it out, device a sectific membership it it to the MDEQ website. Municipalities have a specific membership application form. Environmental Star also has a specific membership application form.
