About the Position:

The Environmental Engineer II serves as a seasoned technical lead within the Construction Stormwater Branch of the Land Disturbance Division. The EE2 independently applies engineering principles and regulatory expertise to ensure proper permitting, evaluation, and compliance of construction stormwater activities statewide. Primary responsibilities include: managing contractors reviewing stormwater applications, including performance monitoring, quality control, and ensuring adherence to MDEQ procedures; reviewing construction stormwater permit applications, plans, and SWPPPs for compliance with state and federal requirements; conducting construction site inspections, documenting findings, coordinating corrective actions, and recommending enforcement actions consistent with established procedures; interpreting and implementing federal and state laws, policies, and regulations related to construction stormwater requirements; preparing technical documents, correspondence, and regulatory evaluations in accordance with state and federal procedures; providing technical assistance to developers, contractors, municipal staff, consulting engineers, and the public; identifying, developing, and implementing process improvements to streamline permitting workflows, improve compliance consistency, and enhance the effectiveness of the Construction Stormwater Branch; assisting with branch level policy development, updates to stormwater permitting requirements, and implementation of statewide stormwater initiatives.
