A Bachelor's Degree in an engineering curriculum from a school or college approved by the Mississippi State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors as of satisfactory standing, preferably with courses in environmental engineering; OR A Master's Degree in an engineering curriculum from a school or college wherein that same engineering curriculum at the undergraduate level is approved by the Mississippi State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors as of satisfactory standing, preferably with courses in environmental engineering; AND A Bachelor's Degree in engineering, engineering technology, or related science curriculum of four (4) scholastic years from a school or college other than those approved by the Mississippi State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, preferably with courses in environmental engineering.

About the Position:

Remedial Project Manager responsible for oversight of contaminated sites to ensure the protection of human health and the environment through the administration of State and Federal laws, regulations, guidance, and scientific problems; applies engineering principles and practices to ensure compliance with environmental laws and regulations while providing management and oversight of contaminated site's assessment and redevelopment; prepares draft letters, reports, and memorandums for review by supervisor concerning technical information that has been submitted or discovered about contaminated sites; preparation and oversight of administrative and enforcement actions; communicating and distributing information to public and interested parties concerning contaminated sites and cleanup; pursues professional development and continuing education (e.g. agency benchmarks, training courses); other duties that are assigned by Supervisor.
